Thanks for your email. My connection to the Goddard family is through a great aunt.

The family is Edward John Goddard, born 1848 Mortlake Surrey, his parents were Thomas and Caroline. Edward John married Elizabeth Margaret Beach in June 1872 in Kensington.

They had four children. Thomas William Beach Goddard (1874), Edward John Goddard (1876), Alice Maud Goddard (1878) and Percy Arthur Goddard (1880).

The family were living in New Windsor Berkshire on the 1881 and 1901 censuses.

Thomas married Avery Helen Burrows in 1903 and Alice married Edward George Flear in 1901.

I would love to contact any descendants of this family as I have come across several photographs that I think might be of the Goddard children.

There is a connection to Bath, as I have a photograph of a lorry with the name J. R. Goddard, Bath, fruit importers, taken in 1930.

Elizabeth Margaret is the daughter of Thomas William Beach, Jam Manufacture, from Brentford Middlesex.

Hope you can help me with my search.

I am also descended from Moyes and Jean Pither through Mosses who lived around Shinfield in C16th. I have traced them into 4 lines so far Abraham in Shinfield, Mary Pither [Royal Pensioner] from Wokingham, the Pither's of Henley on Thames [Bakers] and my line the Pither's of Reading [Coach Builders]. Mosses has Hampshire connections and I think died and was buried there.

I am sure that there are other Goddard/Pither links out there, as so many names are recycled across the generations.

Thanks very much for the reply - I already subscribe to all the magazines you suggested as I have been researching my family history for quite a while now. I suppose if I'm honest I was hoping for a bit of a short cut and thought that maybe someone had already done some research that might have helped. I'm sorry if my previous email was a bit vague but I was trying to keep it brief.

I have already sent for a copy of Stephen's death certificate - which will hopefully confirm his home address (Dedworth being part of Windsor) when he died.

The details I have about his family from the 1901 census are:
