Dear Mrs Freeman,

Your letter of enquiry and brief family tree of your Goddards has been forwarded to me by John Goddard of Accrington.

I have looked at the 1881 census of **Goddards** in Gloucestershire and there are still members of the family living in Stroud and Bisley. I do not have details of the **Teakle** family as it is outside the scope of our collection, but you could have a look for yourself. **Teakle** is a very unusual localised name only found around Stroud and Bisley.

We were approached in 1994 by Mrs J. Bloodworth whose address was "Bod Hyfryd, Ruthin Road, Cadole, MOLD, Chwyd CH7 5LQ" [in Wales] with a similar query as yours. She is descended from Thomas Goddard 1765-1855 and his wife Sarah 1771-1855 which appears to be your Thomas and Sarah. According to her records William married Sarah ..... from Stonehouse, who in the 1881 census was an 82 year old widow living with her son in law William Teakle at Bisley.

I do not know whether Mrs Bloodworth still lives at the address she gave then as she is not a member of our association, but the telephone company tells me that someone named Bloodworth still lives in Cadole [but won't give the telephone number]. I suggest that you contact Mrs Bloodworth; if she does not reply please contact us again and I will give you further details of what she said in her letter.

We do have a member of the association, Leslie Goddard, who is knowledgeable about the area and I will send him a copy of your letter in case he can help further.
