I have received the following from Maggie Kambanis in Toronto. I've referred her to Peter for membership and told her I would pass on her family details to you for information or possible help.

Have also noted emails re Geoff Goddard, RAF but have no records of him or his relatives. Julie's suggestion re Over 60s or reunion magazines seems best. Might he be still living and in Air Force List?

I am told by a Jean Godddard of a wiltshire family that you run a Goddard name web site.  
How would I enroll?

I am not very far back in my grandmother's family.

The only information which I have ( all dates, day/month/year):

George Goddard married Rachel Swadron in 1864 at Winterbourne Bassett in Wiltshire. Children were Margaret, bapt. either 6/2/1865 or 6/12/1865 at Luckington, Wiltshire (my Grandmother), George, bapt. 1874 at Mangotsfield, South Gloucestershire and Edward Thomas, bapt. 1877 at Mangotsfield.

My mum always said that her mum came from Hulavington way, but these records show baptism at nearby Luckington.

Old timers in Luckington say that there were Goddards at a farm over towards Hulavington until about 1935.

I have tracked several Goddards in the area today, but they are all 'immigrants'.

After Rachel and George moved to Gloucestershire, they either straight away, or eventually moved to Vinney Green in the parish of Mangotsfield.

Margaret married my grandfather George Jefferies at St Phillip and St Jacob Bristol 8/7/1880. George Jefferies was born or bapt. 7/9/1857 at Mangotsfield.

I do not know why they married in nearby Bristol when they both came from villages NE of Bristol and the Jefferies family boys for generations seem to have

been coal miners in the village coal mines of S. Gloucestershire (Parkwood, Shortwood, Siston etc.).

there may have been a mine at St Phillilps or perhaps they got married far from home as my grandmother was 2 months pregnant.

Thanks for allyour help. I just sat doown to e mail Jean Goddard to see to whom she had passed on my info, when i found your e mail to me  
The seekers for my family may have been me with the help of Peter Goddard at the TorontoLDS library yesterdayd. Jean gave me Peter's address and we were able to connect immediately.  
He realized that Swadrin was wrong and then I found a different version in my family notes: Swadden.  
However the details of birth andmarriage were just not working out for my g grandparents. I finally, with help because this is all new to me,went to the 1881 census and found Swaddens in Winterbourne Basset and hope to access the 1860 census to try to find my g grandmother and get into her family in that way.  
So if you are publishing the info Jean passed on to you from me there should be a rider as to the fact that it is family memory and not neccessarily exact. I think I looked carefully enough that I would have seen Swaddond and only found Swadden.

Unfortunately I will be possibly be away for an extended time soon, but if I get more reliable info for you to use to amend the present stuff you have, I will forward it to you.
