Dear Mrs Goddard,

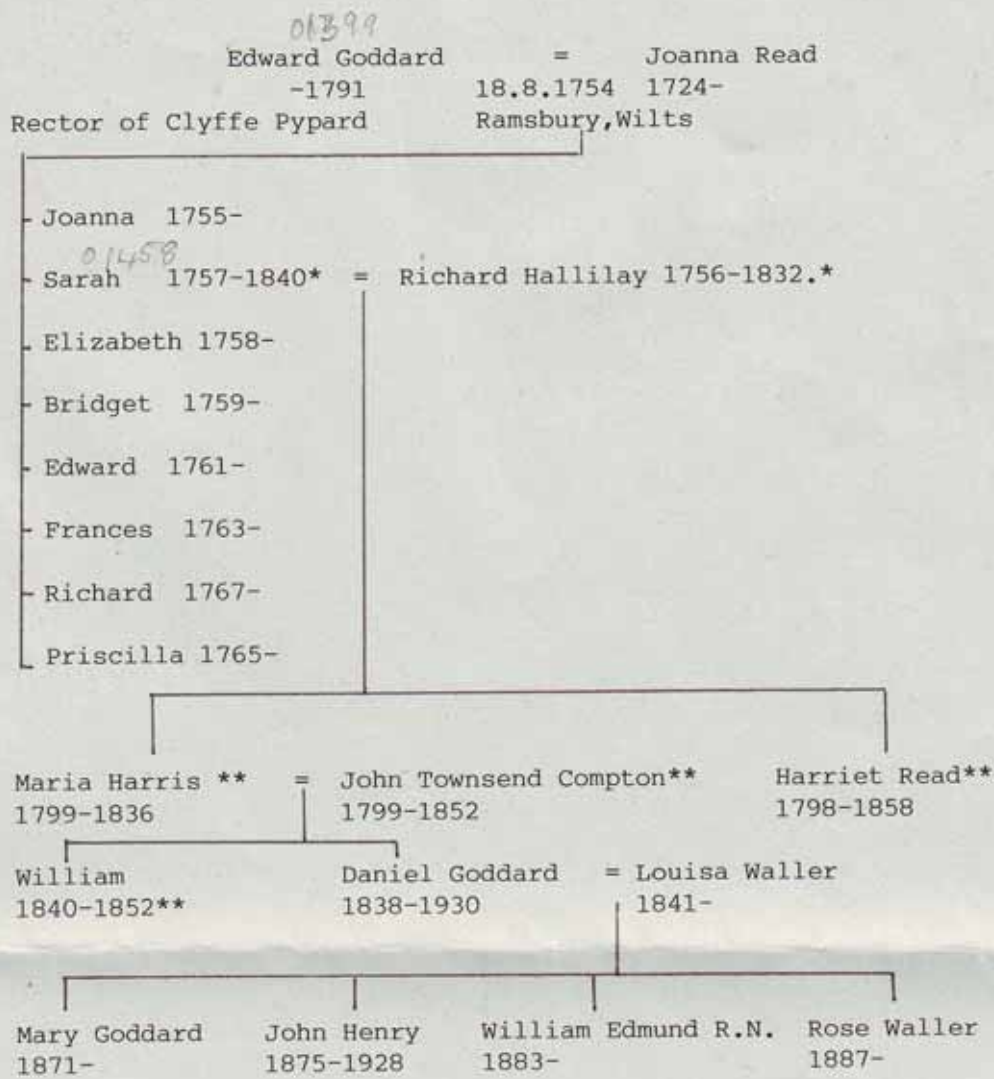
Your plea for the Goddard postcards caught my eye recently and I thought to write to you about a Goddard-Compton connection.

Memorials in Urchfont Church, Wiltshire: \* wall tablet \*\* wall tablet and/or window. The Comptons were an ancient family living near Stonehenge, along the Avon valley, later the senior Compton moved to Ampport in Hampshire. Today they are in several places, but have come in contact again with the Wiltshire branch (no longer in Wilts).

The attendance at Oxford and subsequent ordination of Daniel after his father died was probably financed by his mother's Goddard relations. It would be good to know more about them.

The Hallilay memorial tablet is interesting. Should you be visiting Urchfont (call at the Rectory/ vicarage, the church may be shut) the tablet can only be seen from inside the Vestry.
