INTRODUCTION

This record contains the names of 383 men who died during, or as the immediate result of, the Great War of 1914 to 1919 and who bore the name Goddard or one of its variants. Of these 357 served in the Army, 24 in naval forces and two former Army officers had transferred to the fledgling R.A.F.

Amongst them were 18 officers, 8 Canadians, 4 New Zealanders and 9 serving with Australian units. Three soldiers were awarded the Military Medal. By far the greatest number of casualties occurred in France and Flanders where more than a third have no known grave.

The information has been taken in the main from two published sources.

The Imperial War Graves Commission (now the Commonwealth War Graves Commission) published during the 1920s a booklet for every war cemetery and memorial. These booklets gave details of those buried in each cemetery or, for those with no known grave, listed the names on each IWGC memorial. Each cemetery or memorial is identified by an index letter and number.

Where possible the IWGC consulted next of kin and the information published is therefore greater than that contained in the second published source "Soldiers who died in the Great War of 1914-1919". This was published in 80 sections from War Office casualty records in 1921. A further section listed "Officers who died in the Great War 1914-1919". Each of the 'other ranks' sections is devoted to a particular regiment or corps, numbered from 1 to 80 in order of precedence within the Army. The 'Officers' section follows the same arrangement. The information given is briefer than the IWGC booklets but supplements it by giving place of birth, how the soldier died and in which theatre of action. Curiously there appears to be a hierarchy in the cause of death - killed in action, died of wounds, killed other than in action or died from natural causes, etc.

There are some discrepancies between the two sources and some names in one are not in the other. Where details do not tally I have assumed the IWGC record to be more accurate. Since the recent release of soldier's records at the Public Record Office it may be possible to find further information on the names listed here. Further research remains to be done on those serving in the Royal Navy, Royal Marines and Merchant Navy.

Arrangement

The main sequence of names is of those whose surname was Goddard and is arranged alphabetically by the christian name or initials. Following this is a list of those whose surname is a variant on the usual spelling or who have Goddard as a christian name. This list is arranged in order of the surname.

The layout of each entry is:

- Service number, Rank, Christian name, Regiment or unit
- Place of birth when known. How, where and when died. Age
- Next of kin and other information when known
- Place of burial or Memorial record. IWGC booklet identification number.
