I got in touch with Jim Wishart (whom you put me on to) who replied more or less straight away (his letter dated 15th Sep) with a nice short letter and a copy of his tree (which was more or less confirming my own research) - I've just noticed this letter is degenerating into all brackets! tut tut!! - I replied straight away, sending him my own research findings and about 3 copies of Goddard wills Sid obtained. So far there's been no reply and I've hesitated to get in touch as he'd mentioned he was recovering from an operation. What I would've liked to have asked him was how and where did Anne WALDING come from as the wife of the earliest known Goddard, Michael (see my tree), Jim has lots of "maybes" on his tree and one of them is, I quote " + Anne Waldeig born abt 1700 maybe Jarham, Hampshire married Sept 22 1727 Bentley (etc) died 1739 Bentley "

I've studied Bentley P.R. and there's no marriage, but

noticed on the I.G.1 a marriage at St Mary, Guildford.
G've yet to check on her baptism (161.) as yet. I wondered
if you have anything on Michael and Anne (Walding?).

I would also like to ask you Julie if you have
anything on the Goddards at HUNTON? as G've been
speculating on where Michael could've come from (not
Bentley, there's nothing on him) and there's a Michael (161)
born 23/7/1685 by a Michael ^{GODDARD} and Anney BELTON, they
getting married at Hunton 13/11/1684, and possibly back
further with a Michael being baptised at Hunton 30/4/1660
by a Thomas Goddard. Pure speculation I know but
that's part of the game isn't it!

Also Julie, may I ask if you have anything on my
gt grandmother Emily Goddard (b. 21/6/1867) siblings. You'd
notice her father George was a bit of an itinerant going
by his children's birthplaces, but they settled I believe
in the Clapham, S. London area. I'd love to trace his
children and what became of them. I think possibly his
sons worked on tile and/or mosaic laying (together?)
Any leads would be great. Hope you're keeping well,
and thanks a million for all you've done.

"Hunton" seems to be the flavour of the month; I have had two enquiries about Goddards there lately from John Taylor and Matt Collis. However, I only have their e-mail addresses. I have sent a message to John Taylor and asked him to write to you. I am not sure whether Matt Collis is still interested as he is really looking at the Collis family, so I have asked him to come back to me if he is still looking for Goddards too.

Brian, my husband and keeper of the up-to-date computer, says that there is an Anne Walding baptised at Farnham 4 Oct 1708, father Daniel. A Daniel Walding married Susanna Burchat 4 May 1707 St Mary, Guildford and he may have been her father, however there is also a Daniel Walding marrying earlier in the same place who should be checked out.

I haven't been able to find anything more about the siblings of Emily. You can either write a piece for the Goddard Newsletter to see if anyone recognises their great aunt or uncle; or you can put an advert in *Family Tree Magazine* : or advertise on Teletext, or in *Yours Magazine*. I did find where my great grandmother's sister's family went to from a list in a magazine; you might be lucky too.

We are still trying to clear our desks after taking some time off to organise our daughter's wedding last week. Forgive us if we haven't answered all your questions and do get back with any new findings or queries.

Dear Julie

Many thanks for your message. When I started the article, I did not realise how much space it would take - and neither did the Editor!! I hope that yours is not the only response.

I did not realise that there was a Society such as yours and maybe you can help me, please. I have an elusive line of GODDARDS in the Woonston/Hunton area of Hampshire (this is the Andover, Basingstoke, Winchester triangle. We have recently found the proof of a marriage of a Jane GODDARD and a Thomas TILBURY in Winchester Cathedral on 15 Feb 1723/4. We have been searching for this marriage for some years and even spoke to a Cathedral Archivist who could not at the time produce any evidence.

However, we are now trying to identify the family of Jane GODDARD and have identified some of that name in Hunton but cannot yet prove the connection, and, indeed, we may never be able to.

Do you have any data on GODDARDS in this area at this time that might help, please. If so, I can provide some more 'meat on the bones'.

PS Although the Portsmouth Ward was dedicated to those who died at Jutland, the plaques appear to commemorate also those of the 4th Flotilla who died other than at the Battle of Jutland, since my grandfather died in August 1915. I have no quick or easy way of separating those who died at Jutland from the others.
