Congratulations on getting another step back in your family tree. I shall put your letter in the file for processing and the information to be added to the big index.

The new Hampshire Record Office opened on 26th April, but with only a limited service. It will be in full swing on 1st June - or so the latest Hampshire Family Historian reports. The new address is Sussex Street, Winchester SO23 8TH. The telephone number is the same : (0962) 846154. With luck they will have the records of the Workhouse where Charles was Master and Emily Ann a Relieving Officer. I hope it was at Romsey Workhouse and not the notorious Andover one. You could look for Charles's apprenticeship papers at the Record Office. We found James Robert Goddard of Silchesters papers and they were very illuminating and mentioned several other members of the family and their occupations

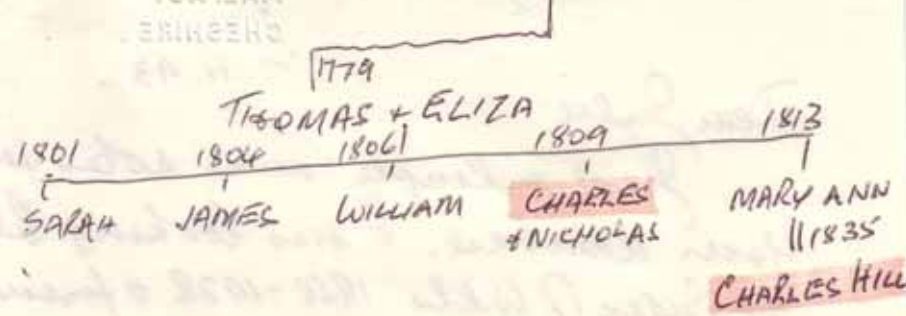
Just a couple more notes for your database. I was looking thro' the Index of Wills 1858-1928 & found the following two entries.

- ① GODDARD, ELIZABETH d. 11.1.1859 Westwellon proved by CHARLES G. son, carpenter and CHARLES HILL, sawyer, son in law.
- ② GODDARD, LUANNA d. 25.5.1866, spinster, ROMSEY. CHARLES G. workhouse master is her brother.

I think I let you have the "free" for the E. Wallow Goddards from MATT GODDARD ca 1700. If I did not go that far back you must let me know. I append the small relevant section.

Dear Mr Goddard,

I believe John Goddard the membership secretary has sent you some details of my great grandmother Sarah Goddard (ca1820-?). These were somewhat vague as I was saying that I hardly expected him to know anything about her.

Here are some more details which I feel are relevant.

1. She married Henry Ellery at Southampton, St Mary on 14.7.1839.
2. Her father's name is given as Charles Goddard on the marriage certificate.
3. In the 1841 census at Romsey Charles' age is given as 50 and Sarah and Henry are living with him and have one child.
4. This indicates that Charles was born about 1790.
5. A Charles Goddard married Phoebe Moody in 1812. Phoebe had an adult christening ten days before she got married (Sherfield English).
6. A Charles Moody was a witness at Sarah and Henry's wedding.
7. Charles Goddard was Registrar of Births Marriages and Deaths at Romsey in 1851 (see 1851 census), his age is given as 27.
8. It may be a coincidence but my cousin Bruce Ellery who was another great grandson of Sarah and Henry was Registrar at Southampton during and after the last war.

I have not had a chance to look up the local parish registers as yet and I feel that Charles and Phoebe were likely to have been Baptists which makes tracing them more difficult, but if you have any records to link them and Sarah it would be a great help.

I enclose a sheet with some families from the Romsey area that I have gleaned from the IGI files in the hope that they may be of some use.

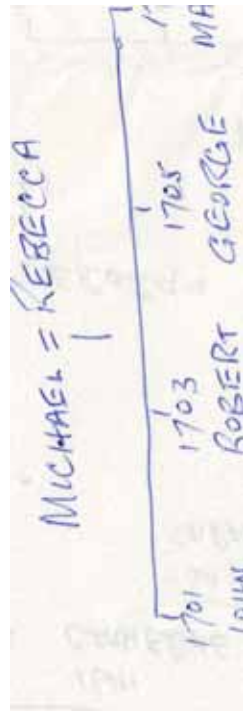

The village of Wellow or in 885. Wellewe - means a stream. (BLUE STREAM) left in King Alfreds will to his daughter Ethelreda. The village church built in the 1200s probably oldest is called St Margarets of Antioch. Little has changed since Tudor times. The church was caught up in the Civil wars, when Cromwells men covered the wall paintings. It was also recorded the horrors of the plague which decimated Wellow 300 years ago. Florence Nightingale is buried at St. Margarets. The Doomsday Book records that Wellow had 2 manors & 2 Mills. Certainly Wellow was a well established Saxon community.

The Red Rover Inn is very old. It was a coaching Inn & was named after one of the most famous coaches. In its time it has been much more than a pub. Serving also as a coroners court. wartime headquarters for the Home Guard & even a butchers shop.
