Thank you for your last letter, I have put your query about where the Lock entry in the IGI came from to Peter Morrall and he will doubtless contact you. I don't want to press him on the subject as he and his wife are getting divorced so he is probably having a stressful time.

I must say that as I get more involved in Goddard research that I agree now that it is quite likely that Brian & I have common ancestors. There are a few "loose ends" and if we went back a bit further who knows what we might find?

With regard to your kind offer to check anything specific, the only weak link is Sarah Goddard's birth record which I think will be in the Ebenezer Baptist Church at Sheffield English and somebody is looking into this for me now.

It is possible that there are ~~two~~^{four} wills at Winchester which would interest me very much.

In 1601 Christian Goddard ^{was born to} Alice Goddard at LOCKERLEY
& in 1651 Thomas Goddard and Anne had a Son Thomas at LOCKERLEY.
I suspect that the Thomas who was born in 1651 might be a brother to Matthew who was born 1653 & who married Dinah Lock. I have ^{a copy of} his will, perhaps you would

Now what I would like to ask you is this-Nicholas came from Lindsey in Suffolk. Could you please check whether any Goddard wills (probably pages 20 & 23 RWKG) for Suffolk Goddards refer to this Nicholas?

Dear Edward,

The Suffolk wills on page 20 and 23 are enclosed:
(except that I omitted to photocopy page 21 which reads as follows:

"...which I entered into upon marriage of son Robert Goddard with wid. Elizabeth Dandy, to be paid or son to enter into piece of land of about 10 ac. called "Stubbinge", held by copy of the Manor of Cotton Bressworth. Christopher Goddard, youngest son, £80, £40 at 24 or within 7 years after my decease, and £40 at 26. All these payments to be made in the south porch of Parish Church of Barton. Four children of George Roper of Budwell 10s each. Kinsman Edward Sayward of Newton. Thomas, Christopher and Elizabeth, wife of son Robert, £10 each and upwards due on a bond from brother Christopher Goddard equally divided between them. John Goddard, son of brother Christopher. Poor of Barton. Residue to wife and son Christopher. Wife and Thomas executors.

Witnesses: William Rey and Edmund ffemoord

Proved in London 11 April 1656 by Thomas Goddard, son, one of executors.

Unfortunately all the records so carefully compiled by Miss Kathleen Goddard of the Suffolk Goddards are not available for consultation. She left them to a niece who lives in Coventry, while the records are in Suffolk. We are trying to negotiate a solution.

I telephoned Hampshire Record Office about the inscription at Lockerley and they confirm that their record gives the surname as HOBART. The inscription is in Latin, they say, but the names are in English. The only way to check further is to consult the microfiche

record of the burials register of Lockerley in the Hampshire Record Office. I am not sure when we will be going back to Winchester (the A34 is having work done on it and I avoid traffic jams whenever possible), but I could request someone else to check if you think that it is PROBABLE rather POSSIBLE that the name is GODART not HOBART.
