James Robert Goddard, wife Louisa & family of seven, left Gravesend for New Zealand in the ship "Winchester" on May 3rd 1874, landing at Napier, Hawkes Bay, N.Z on the 26th July, 1874. " She made a smart passage of 84 days & brought out 457 immigrants"

This was how my Great Grandfather brought his family to their new country. My Grandfather was the second son, George Robert. He married a Emma Brown of Wellington c. 1890. When my father was about 8 yrs old, the family left Napier & moved to join up with Fred Goddard, the 4th son of original family, to try their hand at farming as well. Fred had moved over to the west coast south of Kawhia harbour when the land was opened up for settlement after the Maori wars. This whole district has been known as the King Country since those times. The town I live in now was at the time the border town, beyond us was where the Maori had hid himself away.

My Grandparents had 11 children altogether, two of them dieing as infants. Only one Aunt is still living & she wont tell me much of their life on the farm. Was very hard for her she said. As a child I spent every possible holiday that I could on one of the farms of the family still out there. The Grandparents moved into town, Hamilton, when George lost a leg. I can remember him, tall, gruf bristly moustache, & peg-leg. When the Goddards & the first pioneers went out into that area it was covered by native bush, thick & beautifull; now it is just as beautifull with grass covered hills & valleys.

Aunt Gwen gave me a copy of the document of apprenticeship of her fathers. It had been handed down from James Robert the original settler. Now, you have had it in one of your newsletters, sent by my cousin George. At least I know him as George. I dont think he was fully aware of whom it belonged to. The Stephen & Hannah Goddard, parents, must have been our Great Great Grandparents.

\* These two, Stephen & Hannah along with George Rouw & wife Mary, nee Wiggeard are of great interest to me. Is it possible someone could do some searching for me? Seems to be several spellings of Wiggard. Fancy no one really knows the correct one. Gwen told me that there were several other names in old papers she had seen. Oldfield & Churchill being two. Possibly family connections.

You will have heard from a Margaret Goddard of Otorohanga. Her husband is a Grandson of Fred Goddard. She & I are working more or less together on the search. You will have realised by now that my typing is far from the best! :- but feel you will follow better than my writing.

The Fred Goddard descendants had a reunion couple years ago. & I am sending some papers that I got at that time. I hope at some time in the future to have another reunion, out back, for descendants of both the Goddard families.

The family have carried the tradition of carpentary of some sort in every generation. Grandfather was a coachbuilder, like his Dad, My father was joiner, as is my brther & my nephew. Myself I make pottery houses, sometimes from photos. My eyes lit up when Frank Goddard showed me photo of Goddard Manor House. Someday we will come back to Britain & I will see for myself & make one.

I had travelled to Scotland met & married there & raised a family; now back not far from bithplace, Hamilton, managing a motel. Planning a holiday next year. back to Edinburgh, England.

Hope you can follow all this info & that I have remembered all I hoped to put down!

Several months ago (nearly a year I think!) I received a letter from a Peter Beck enquiring of a Charles Allen G. b.1820. He had one family tree which gave Charles Allen being in 1836. I was able to write & tell him that there had been two Charles Allens..

1. Charles ALLEN b.1767. d.10.1.1836 ..was Hannah Goddards Father (my G.G.G.Grandmother)
2. Charles Allen GODDARD ..bap.4.5.1820 Silchester...was elder brother of my G;G;Granfather - Stephen & Hannahs 2nd son.

Charles A. Goddard had left Silchester as a journey man Carpenter, married Fanny Harding of Bradford, Peverell, Dorchester & had 8 of a family.

His 2nd son, Joel G. married Ellen Whitburn had 10 of a family, the youngest, Nellie ate being Peter Becks Mother.

Of Stephen & Hannahs family the only one we have no info. on is Mary Ann, bap. 1827, Silchester.

Was very nice to welcome Peter & wife Marion, to our 'clan'... we will see them in New Milton, Eng. in June.

The other wonderful news...Peter had done some research & was able to tell me where a missing G. Uncle was.....When my G.G.Grandfather, James Robert & his 2nd wife, Louisa & their 8 children came over in 1874, they presumably, left behind his 3 elder children from his first marriage...well Peter found the eldest, William along with a wife & 2 children.
