

Dear Mrs Goddard,

Thank you for your enquiry re Mary Charlotte GODDARD. There are no burials for this name between 1817 and 1837. I am enclosing a list of all the Mary Goddard burials in the index 1817-1837, in case she was buried without her middle name being mentioned, but there are none in Winchester and none of an age which would match with a birth date of 1817.

If Mary Charlotte died after 1837, you will have to consult the GRO indexes for a death certificate.



Dear Mrs. Goddard,

Thank you for your letter of the 27th September enclosing a cheque for £5.00 receipt of which is acknowledged.

I have searched ten parish registers for the baptism of George Goddard and finally traced it in the Parish of St. Michael, Winchester, on the 29th February 1852, a copy of the entry is enclosed.

Among these searches I also came across the baptism of another of Thomas and Mary Goddard's children, Keziah, on the 29th July 1849 in the Parish of St. Peter, Cheeshill, Winchester. A copy of this baptism entry is also enclosed.

Since the date of this last baptism was sufficiently close to the 1851 Census I searched the census and have found the 1851 Census entry for Thomas and Mary Goddard and family. I enclose a copy of this entry.

As you can see there were at least another four children of Thomas and Mary and it raises the question as to whether George Goddard was married twice. If the Census entry is correct you will note that Charles was born in 1833 approximately, whereas George and Mary (Collins) were married in 1837. ^{Thomas} 2

I have not so far researched the registers from 1880-1890 for the baptisms of Minnie or Nell Goddard or for any further information of James and Frances Goddard in the late 18th /early 19th Century. I will continue with these enquiries, unless I hear to the contrary and write again in due course.
