I haven't indexed the Goddard marriages - it's a project that is definitely in mind but I haven't yet got around to it - so I can't easily look this up for you but I will if it will help.

However, I wonder whether it will serve any purpose. How would your correspondent know whether we had found the right James if he doesn't know the name of the wife? Do you know what steps he has taken to find this out? Is the "sentence of 10 years transportation" something that has come from the passenger list or has he actually got the sentencing document? I presume the trial would have taken place at the Winchester Assize. Do we know that he was living at Hawley at the time or has this just been assumed because he was born there?

If he was indeed married, then a dime to a donut (as they say here) there was a child or children. Then if he was sent to Australia chances are the wife and kids went on Parish relief. LDS Film No. 1470833 covers the Vestry Books for Hawley so if she did (and they were living at Hawley) then there is probably a note there about the transportation. Again, if they were married at Hawley, then LDS Film No. 0991711 would record that marriage.

If it were me I would get the Assize documents before proceeding further.

I wonder if you can help with the following: Russell Hudson's great grandfather was James Goddard born 1822 in Hawley, Hants. He was found guilty of theft in 1845 and at his trial said that he was married. He was sentenced to 10 years transportation to Australia. Here he married in 1853 saying that he was a widower. Do you have any marriages for a James Goddard between 1837 and 1845 in Hawley, Yateley or Cove in Hampshire? Our records stop at 1837 for this area. AGM went off quite well, about 30 there, but there had been no publicity except for the Newsletter to members. The weather was cold and no one sat out on the river side this year.
