Dear Mrs Duncombe,

*I enclose the Goddards who were potters in Deptford St Paul in the 1881 census. As you will see from the accompanying sheet, they weren't the only Goddards living in the place by any means.*

*Henry A. was born in Boughton under Blean and your next step might be to look at the registers for the place. I see that there are four entries in the I.G.I. for Kent from Boughton, but there may have been more Goddards than that living in the place over the centuries. The I.G.I. is by no means complete. I would have had a look at my print out of the Goddards in Kent in 1881 for other Goddards who were born in Boughton, but no longer living there, but I have misfiled it at the present moment.*

*Boughton under Blean is a ;ittle difficult to find on a map, but Arthur Mee's Kings England book on Kent gives it as a small village on the Canterbury to Sittingbourne road. He says "Just a street, but what a street! It lies between grassy banks, with trees and huge barns and old cottages everywhere. The Tudor fronts are splendid. The church is far away among the fields. The Blean was a forest in Chaucer's day, and is still richly timbered..."*

*Note that Henry A. must have been very deaf as the census enumerator has made a note of it. I imagine that he had had to have a shouted conversation with him.*

*At the moment we do not have any other Goddards with a family tree similar to yours. We do have the descendatns of James Robert Goddard, who married Louisa Roux in 1859 as members, living in new Zealand. And I am also researching Henry Goddard, the shipbuilder of Chatham, born 1580 and his descendants belong to the association. Your letter will be kept in the file and you will be notified if anything turns up.*

*I enclose a leaflet about the GAE and a recent Newsletter. I shall put a small piece in it about you and your ancestors, but feel free to expand on it and write an article yourself. Send your £5 to John Goddard at Accrington and write that you have been in contact with me.*

Dear Mr. & Mrs. Goddard,

I have been given your name and address by a Mr. Goddard from Cornwall, who noted, in the latest edition of the North West Kent FHS quarterly journal, I was researching the name.

I have only been researching for the past 3 years, and am trying to trace **all** the names in my ancestry, which is a mammoth task as you might imagine! I am now concentrating on Goddard.

My maternal grandfather was **Francis George Goddard**, born in **Deptford** on **8.8.1881**. In 1889 he was taken to Oxfordshire by a wealthy benefactor, Charles Edward Baring Young, one time M.P. for Christchurch, Hants, and was one of the 1st children to attend the newly founded school at Kingham Hill. (He remained there until he retired in 1947, eventually becoming the schools bursar/accountant). I only ever knew he was an orphan. I have subsequently found that his parents both died of tuberculosis, **Father Henry (Harry) Allwright** (born on **2.2.1857**) on **28.3.1887** and Mother Alice (nee Oakes) on 7.3.1890. I also discovered that he had 4 siblings, **Alice** born **27.3.1879**, **Harry Oakes** born **18.10.1880** and **2 sisters** as yet untraced. **Henry Allwright Goddards** Father was **Henry Francis Goddard** and he was born **c1834**, marrying Sophia Rebecca Allwright on 30.12.1855 at Lewisham. I believe his father was **Henry Arthur Goddard** born **c1812** in Boughton Kent, marrying Matilda ?.

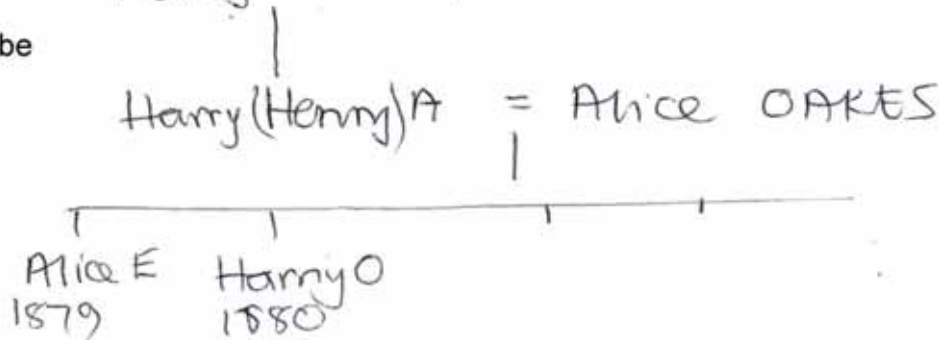
Are you able to shed any additional light on any of this information? I know **Harry Oakes Goddard** was in the **Brixton Orphanage in 1891** and I believe I have names of some of Henry Francis Goddards siblings, **Ann b1833**, **Euphenna b1836**, **Donald b1840**, **Matilda b1846** and **Donald b1850**.
