Dear Julie

Thank you for your e-mail. This referred to your "notes of yesterday". Perhaps I'm having a senior moment [!], but I've searched my incoming e-mails & I can't seem to find anything received from you yesterday. Perhaps you could re-send it as I'm sure that it would be of interest.

These are the details I am sure of:

My great grandfather was George Goddard, a fisherman, who is shown on my Grandfather Samuel's birth certificate [see below]. My great grandmother was Sarah Goddard ["formerly Pearcey or Piercey - it's not clear on Samuels' birth certificate]. I am trying to trace further back - but so far it appears that George & Sarah may have married before 1837 as I've been unable to locate their marriage certificate. Of course, since George was a fisherman, he may have met up with Sarah away from Ramsgate. I also don't have the ages of either George or Sarah at the time of Samuels' birth in 1844.

My grandfather was Samuel Goddard who was born on the 6th of May 1844. He died at sea on the vessel "VESTA" in 1900 [list of Marine Deaths 1896-1900]. Samuel married Ann Harley [or Farley - again not 100% clear on the marriage certificate] on Jan 15th 1865 and they had at least two daughters. They separated and Ann & her daughters appear in Lambeth in the 1891 and 1901 censi. Samuel later married[?] Ellen Knott [a widow] and my father was one of their children.

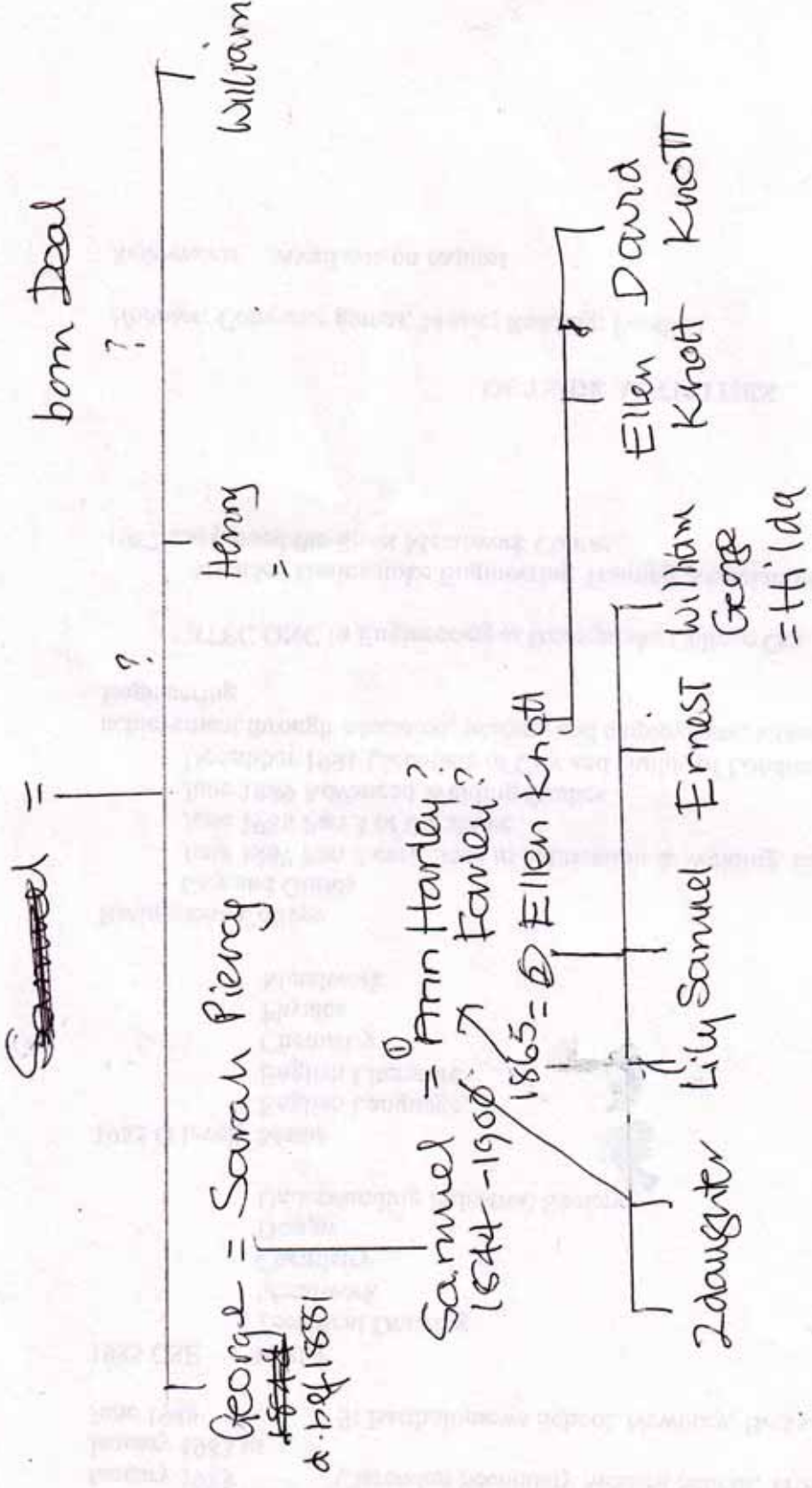
Samuel & Ellen's family are shown in the 1891 census, living at 61 Hardres Street, Ramsgate, with two Knott children [Ellen & David] and four Goddard children. These were Samuel; Ernest [went to USA with a Knott[?] uncle around 1910 & was last heard of in New York or Brooklyn in 1930 approx]; William George [my father] and Lily. Ellen Knott is shown in the 1881 census as a widow of 35 years, with 5 children [including Ellen & David]. My father was originally registered under the name of "Gorred" [Ellen Knott probably could neither read nor write]. This was later corrected and his surname legally changed back to Goddard.

My father married Hilda Gertrude Minns on 6th December 1917. They had three daughters and one son, me!

My Uncle Sam moved to Plymouth at the beginning of WWII and died there in 1965. Aunt Lily married a Mr Marshall and I have Marshall cousins and second cousins in the USA & Australia. There's a lot of salt water in our Goddards! George, Samuel and my Uncle Sam were fishermen. My father, William George, spent from 1905 to 1919 in the Royal Navy.

I plan to research the 1851 & 1871 censi at the LDS Family History Centre in Kings Lynn to shed more light on the family in Ramsgate. My main thrust is to try to find great grandfather George's father and mother. Then, if possible to go back even further. If you have any thoughts on this, I'd be pleased to have them.

Dear Gerald,

We have at last had an enquiry from someone who might be related to you.

The 1881 census lists your proven ancestor Richard Daniel Goddard at home with his father Thomas aged 60 and Lavinia aged 47 (was she his second wife?). I recall that we had some correspondence with you over Rhoda because she was born in Stockcross just outside Newbury.

Our enquirer has got his tree back to Thomas (born 1857) who was a waterman at Greenwich and his wife Frances (31) and children Frances (9), Thomas (7) and Alice (4 months). I have suggested that he gets Thomas's birth certificate, or marriage certificate and checks his father's name and occupation. However, it occurs to me that you might already have this information.

Dear Mr Peeke,

In reply to your e-mail:

There were several Goddard families in Kent in the 1881 census, which does not surprise me as in many places in England it is quite a common name.

You were asking about Thomas aged 34 a waterman, his wife Frances 31, children Frances (9), Thomas (7) and Alice 4 months, all born in Greenwich.

There was also Thomas (60) a Trinity Pilot (ie worked for Trinity House, the Corporation responsible for lighthouses, light vessels, buoys and beacons), wife Rhoda (47) (second wife?) and various children. This Thomas could have been Thomas's father. If you think it possible I do have someone who is descended from Thomas senior who might be able to help. I suggest that you obtain Thomas's birth certificate, or marriage certificate and check his parent's names.

We also had an enquiry in 1992 about William Goddard (60) born Dartford who was an engineers lab[ourer] with a wife named Sarah nee Wood, but I don't think that this is the family you are looking for.

I enclose a leaflet about our association. Before divulging detailed information we ask for at least one annual donation - quite a modest amount when researchers charge £10 an hour, minimum £30.

Dear Brian and Julie,

I wonder if you are able to help me with the following query re. Goddards:

I have a proven ancestor, Richard Daniel Goddard, born 11.5.1857 Greenwich, who was a schoolmaster - possibly a headmaster. He had two sons: Richard Newton G., bpt. 13.6.1883, and Walter James, two years younger. This information should all be on your computer records.

In a parcel of books which have been stowed away for some considerable time, I have recently discovered a copy of "The Leisure Hour, 1884", bearing the following inscription:

" Presented to Richard Newton Goddard  
with kindest love from Grandpapa  
to commemorate his 36th year as  
Schoolmaster.

May 1885. "

My late mother had enclosed a note saying that the book had belonged to my grandfather's brother, i.e. Richard Daniel G.

I have come to the conclusion that the Richard Newton Goddards cannot be one and the same. The one who received the book would have been born 1885 - (36 +, say, 20) = ca. 1830. So who was he? The name Richard Newton G. is not common, yet the owner of the book was a school teacher, the same as Richard Daniel G. Also, the "Grandpapa" is perplexing. Assuming Richard Newton G. was around 55 years old when he received the book, is it likely that his grandfather was still alive!

So, two questions:

- (1) have you any record of a Richard Newton G. born ca. 1830;
- (2) if you haven't, might it be possible to raise the query in the next issue of the Newsletter, please?

I hope you are both keeping well. Dorothy and I still plod along - busy with music-making, dog-walking, golf, etc. Goodness knows how I found time to go to work!

Dear Julie,

Thank you for your letter of the 2nd May. It was interesting to know you may have found another relative of mine.

There may be a mistake in your enquirer's notes - unless there are two Thomas Goddards (not related), born in 1847 and 1857 respectively.

I only know of a Thomas, born 1.3.1847 - the first child of 1820 Thomas and his first wife, Sarah Ann Preddy (second cousins). The 1847 Thomas, who became a Waterman, married Frances Maria Hawkings, 24.8.1870. They had 10 children spread over 22 years (poor Frances Maria!!). They were:

Frances Ellen b. 3rd qtr. 1871  
Thomas Richard b. 2.4.1874  
Elizabeth Maria b. 2nd qtr. 1877  
Alice Rhoda b. 15.11.1880 d. 17.7.1964  
Agnes Rosetta b. 1882 d. 24.1.1962  
Henry Howes b. 15.12.1884 B. 13.11.1889  
Arthur Benjamin b. 13.5.1887 B. 13.11.1889 d. 1973  
Albert Victor b. 25.8.1889 B. 13.11.1889 d. 29.2.1956  
William Stanley b. 8.10.1891 d. 1976  
Alfred George b. 16.3.1893

As regards Richard Daniel, he was born 11.5.1857 - the first child of 1820 Thomas and his second wife, Rhoda Povey. Richard D. married Sarah ? and they had two sons, Richard Newton, B. 13.6.1883, and Walter James, B.8.7.1885.

I enclose photocopies of my notes from the 1871 and 1881 Censuses and also of relevant pages from the 1891 Census, which you may care to pass on to your enquirer. You will find no mention of a Lavinia on the 1881 Census and I have never heard of her, although Rhoda is listed there and she was 47.
