JConsb.e? Can't make it out.) Radcliffe, Vic.r; On Sunday the 10th Nov.r (illegible) Radcliffe, Vic.r; On Sunday the 7th Nov.r D. Palmer, Curate." (Obviously, the 7th wasn't a Sunday! The top of the page reads 1811.)

The entry (#701 on p. 88 under "Baptisms solemnized in the Parish of Strood in the County of Kent in the Year 1821") reads: "Aug.st 12th - William - John & Mercy - Goddard - Strood (Abode) - Hair dresser (Quality, Trade or Profession) - E. M. Allfice? Allsice? Curate".

In 1861, the family had a hairdresser's apprentice living with them named John Goodwin, age 16, born in Maidstone.

In 1871, the family had another apprentice living with them named John W. Belsey, age 16, born in Stelling.

In 1881, the family had a live-in domestic servant named Rosina Jennings, age 16, born in Charing, Kent.

There is yet another William Goddard, born about 1830 in Sevenoaks, Kent and living in Lee, Kent in 1881 with wife Jane S., daughters Jane M., Jessie A., and Lily A. (Lily born in Strood!), plus son Thomas A. William is a hairdresser too! Any connection?

In April 1892, Edmund Kingsford appointed his "brother-in-law" (he was married to Mary's sister Caroline) as co-executor to his will, along with Mary and Caroline's brother Hammond Upton. The executors were left 20 pounds each for their pains. Edmund drew up a similar will a year later and promptly died. The wills were posted by Shelley Haigger on the Folkestone Families web site (<http://freepages.genealogy.rootsweb.com/~folkestonefamilies>) and I found them on February 21st, 2005. As a matter of interest, William is described as "William Goddard gentleman of Folkestone". Brother-in-law Hammond Upton is described as "carpenter"...

On his son William Day Goddard's marriage certificate (1875), William Goddard is also described as a "gentleman". How does a hairdresser become a gentleman?

Maybe he sells insurance! The Post Office Directory for 1855 has a William Goddard listed as an insurance agent for "East of England Life" on High Street which is where he was probably living at the time. (He's also listed as "hairdresser, perfumer, and toy wareho. High street".)

He married MARY MONICA HYDE July 06, 1875 in Christ Church, Folkestone, daughter of GEORGE HYDE. She was born December 30, 1847 in Wansted, Essex, England, and died May 04, 1938 in Folkestone, Kent, England.

The death of a William Goddard (age 57) was registered in the district of Ashton Under Lyne, Lancashire, January-March 1908, vol. 8d, p. 454. Monica Goddard gave William Goddard's death year as 1907, and I know that a Mary Monica Hyde appears in the 1901 Census, living in Lancashire. Visiting his wife's relatives, perhaps?

Of William's three sons who survived to adulthood, Frederick went to Oxford, Archibald Spencer went to Cambridge, and Ralph is described in *Our Treasured Roots: A History of Gibbons and Surrounding Areas* as being "one of the few in the district who had the benefit of a college and university education" (p. 185, probably written by one of the Brumfits, another Gibbons family). Where did the money come from to educate these young men? According to Paul Goddard's autobiography *Wings of the Morning: Memoirs of a Flying Vicar*, published 1996 (p.3), Frederick and Archibald won scholarships to their respective universities.

Here's another mystery: William Day Goddard is listed in "Kelly's Directory of Kent 1913" as living at 93 Cheriton Road! Maybe Mary Monica hadn't had his name removed?

And yet another mystery! Where does the "Day" come from? "Day" is a very common surname in Kent, and I think it must be a family name from a couple of generations back. Perhaps the maiden name of whoever married John Goddard's father back in the eighteenth century?

Notes for MARY MONICA HYDE:

Mary Monica Hyde may have sat on Queen Victoria's knee as a small child, according to legend. The source here is Monica Goddard Wolff (as far as I can recall; she would have told us in 1981). In Paul Goddard's autobiography (*Wings of the Morning: Memoirs of a Flying Vicar*, published 1996, ISBN 1 899526 75 7), Canon Goddard has this to say about the "Lady Monica Hyde" (some say "Lady Mary Hyde") family legend: "Returning for a moment to the eighteenth century, during a Wesleyan revival, a young man found himself kneeling alongside a young woman. Besides finding the Lord that night, they found each other. They were my great-grandparents. The girl in question was Lady Monica Hyde, and the Spencer family with which she was connected was part of the Royal Household at Windsor. Spencer was supposed to have been the last man to see King George III alive, while his son and friends gambled in a coach below on how long the old boy would last. I mention this for two reasons. First, it explains the reason for Spencer occurring as a Christian name in the family, as also Monica . . . The second reason is to account for certain pieces of furniture which are reputed to have come from Windsor Castle -- the sofa table, the square gate-legged table in Janey's (Paul's 3rd daughter) house and the small round table in Jeremy's (Paul's eldest) house. I remember when I was small seeing a number of pigeon boxes with George III crest on them. Where did they go?" (pp. 2-3) (Better not let the Royal Family get wind of these, Paul!) Just to clarify things, Paul's great-grandparents on his paternal side were William Goddard (a hairdresser) and Mary Upton (who had no noble connections that I could find; her dad was a grocer); and George Hyde (a gardener) and whomever he married. So far, all marriages and christenings I have found for these branches of the family are Church of England, not Wesleyan at all, as far as I know...  
Mary Monica's birth year is listed as 1849 in the 1881 British Census.  
Birth is registered January-March 1848, district of West Ham, Essex, vol. 12, p. 253\* (which indicates an error in transcription).

Along with Mary Monica's birth and marriage registrations, the FreeBMD index has the birth and marriage registrations for another Mary Monica Hyde! This one's birth was registered in the district of Prestwich (which includes Harpurhey), Lancashire July-September 1883, vol. 8d, p. 408 and her marriage was registered July-September 1907 in the district of Camberwell (south London). In the 1901 British Census, I find a Monica Hyde, born about 1857 in Manchester, a "retired grocer" living in Harpurhey. There are a number of other Hydes in Harpurhey as well. What's the connection?

Married in the Parish Church according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church after Banns by me, E. P. (?) Gregg, Curate. This Marriage was solemnized between us, W. D. Goddard, Mary Monica Hyde in the Presence of us, Geo. Hyde, H. Jarvis."

Michael's sister Dorothy Wolff said, in an email dated March 24th, 2005: "I don't know a lot about the story (of parental disapproval of William Day Goddard's marriage to Mary Monica Hyde), but the Goddard grandparents stayed in Alberta with Mummy's family when she was little. Her Grandmother Monica was the 'original' Monica Goddard that she and I and Holly were named after (although I think Holly's Monica came from Mum) and Mummy loved her very much -- unlike her Grandmother Woodward (Elizabeth--

that's why she never liked the name!). Grandfather Goddard was a musician or an artist and his father had never approved of his choice of 'lifestyle' although I think the family must have been well enough off, because Grandpa was sent out to Alberta for his health and his brother was able to travel although officially working for the HBC and Paul's father went to a good school. But what Mummy said was that (her) Grandpa Goddard (I never knew his name -- isn't that interesting that Gareth has William too!) had been disinherited for his marriage and for not going into the profession or job or whatever that the family had chosen for him. The Hyde pictures that Grannie and Grandpa had up in Edmonton must have been his mother's parents, then. " This rift might explain the sudden change in parishes for the marriage; W.D.'s parents lived in the St Mary and St Eanswythe parish.
