I am a child of the second marriage. I know very little about his first wife or children, except to say that he had two girls and one boy by his first marriage and a girl and boy by his second. (shown on my family tree) He waited for the death of his first wife before he married my mother. this was late in his life and he died a couple of years after this event.

The information about the photo's.

In the 1920's my father was involved in the music business as a performer. At one time he was a member of Jack Hylton's band.

The photo on the left shows him with members of his own band that was called Arthur Clifford's Salon Band. The Arthur Clifford being his stage name. (My father is centre) This photo is the same one that was published in the Radio Times dated Sept. 2nd 1927 I believe it was the first time that a photo of a band had been printed in this publication. He was performing from the Cardiff studios (station call sign 5WA) of the BBC. The program was transmitted at 10.30 pm - 11.00pm and was advertised as Dance Music.

There is very little that I can add to this family mystery, maybe with the associations help and more research it will develop.

Thank you for your letter and welcome to the Goddards.

I have now received your family tree and your letter. I presume the article you mention went to John Goddard of Accrington did it? A short article in the Goddard newsletter might jog someone's memory.

We found your grandmother Lillian Tinsley in the 1881 census and William J. Goddard, her future husband. Details enclosed.

Tracing your father's life through the band might be difficult. Roy Hudd has an extensive Music Hall record collection; the Theatre Museum collects theatre material and the Circus Fans Association collects circus records, but I do not know of anyone who has collected dance band information, nor do I know anyone recording BBC history. However, if you advertised in say, "Yours Magazine", or on Teletext, someone might emerge who knew all about them. I have just rung a knowledgeable friend and she suggests that you could approach the Musicians Union. Or you could consult back copies of The Melody Maker at the Newspaper Library in Colindale. Some future suggestions were coming by mail, but have not yet arrived.

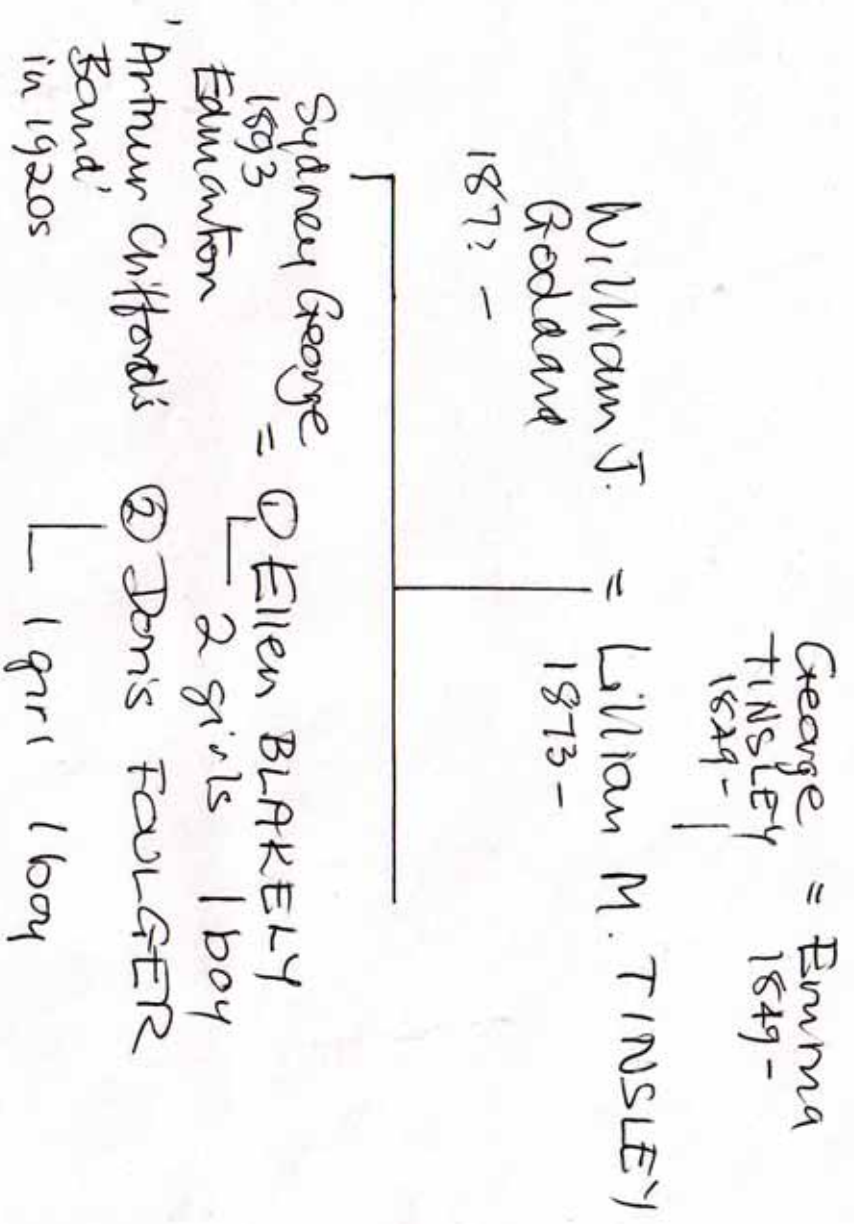
I hope that we have been some help. Do get back to me if you have any queries.

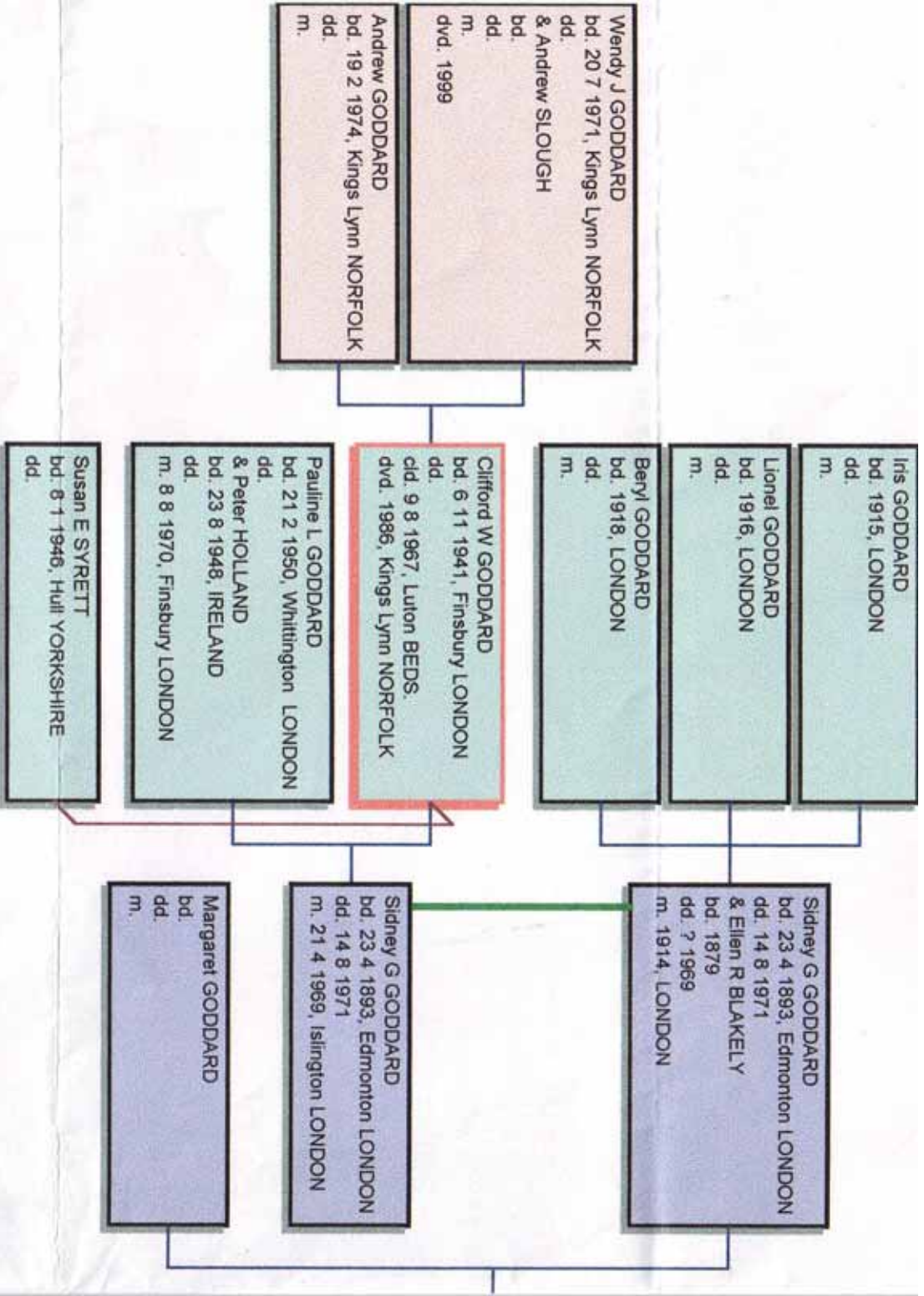
