Dear Brian,

Thank you for the copy of the "The Goddards" which arrived safely this morning. When I have completed reading it I will deposit it in the Goddard document collection in a room set aside in the library that is attached to Devizes Museum in Wiltshire. The book is a very useful addition to the various Goddard family tree information that has been archived there.

I was hoping to see that the line from your Samuel could be traced back to the Samuel and Rebecca (nee Lowden) Goddard, however, by combining our information I believe it can be seen that they are from two unrelated families. The Henry Samuel, son of Samuel and Rebecca was born on the 13th February 1790 and baptised on the 21st February 1790 at St Clement Danes, (as was his sister Louisa the following year) and is therefore 10 years older than the Samuel in your branch. Your Samuel is consistent when giving his age from census to census. So your book does not clear up my mystery but may help many others and I think that we have both left enough work to be done to keep a generation of researchers busy for a while. We don't want all the glory for ourselves do we?

If you have a spare copy I am sure that the Society Of Genealogists in Chancery Lane London would make very good use of one if were donated to their library.

I am hoping that my monograph and the trees of the Banbury/Bristol/Market Harborough Holland Goddard family, (not related to the Cove/Farnborough or the Manchester area Holland Goddard families), will be published by the Goddard Association in time for their AGM in May next.

Many thanks for yours of the 22nd and enclosures
 As you see I am returning them - not that I am
 ungrateful - quite the opposite - I keep thinking of all the
 care, trouble and hardwork that has gone into the compilation
 of all that information. Sadly nothing connects with the
 Brentford Goddards for which I was hoping. Somebody
 somewhere would be overjoyed to receive them if what was
 contained therein hit their particular jackpot - so it would
 be unfriendly of me to hang on to them. I make use of your
 envelope and unfranked stamp - unscrupulous as I am!

What set me off on this Holland thing was some information given
 me which had been retained by a Brentford Godard one of
 whose antecedents had made some attempt at family history.

It was in answer to an enquiry of the vicar of St Pauls Brentford
 about fifty years ago - I quite.

"I have now made a search of the baptismal registers from 1784 to 1804
 and the only trace of the Goddard name are :-

1792 3rd Dec. George Augustus was baptised, the son of Samuel and
 Rebecca Goddard.

5th Mar. 1800 John Holland son of Samuel & Rebecca Goddard, privately
 baptised 20th Feb 1797, was received into Church and so
 was Clarissa, daughter of the above who was privately baptised

4th Oct 1794

Baptised on the same day was Alfred son of the said Samuel
 & Rebecca

The name Holland intrigued me. I thought that it had come down from a recent female line as was usual. Until I received your information I had no idea that its connection with the Goldards was so ancient and so widespread. One reason for writing you was to endeavour to get a response from the lady you thought would help my Brentford Goldard research. I would appreciate your help in this direction. Many many thanks.

Dear Julia

I expect you have received many letters such as this that include the question "are we related?" Let me say at the outset that I am not a Goddard - only related by marriage - but I have been researching "my" Goddards for a long time and have come to a full stop at the 1837 - 1841 barriers.

The furthest back I can get is a Samuel Goddard, b. 1800 Mangrove married to Elizabeth Clerk b. 1801 Bayham, Wiltshire, at Hanwell Mddx, 31st Mar. 1820

Samuel is described as a "Broker" in this case - the old meaning of the word is used - He was originally a brokers man what we used to call in the East End seventy years ago - a bum. He later went into dealing in furniture and from his small beginnings sprang the present firm of P. Goddard & Sons Ltd still dealing in Brentford Mddx

When I first started on this Goddard research I was guided to the present head of the family explaining what I was doing and asking for his assistance. The reply was full of enthusiasm for the project but practical assistance, despite my many overtures, was not forthcoming. His daughter took up one of my appeals but I faced no better with her. So eventually I had to go my own way and as far as the Goddards in Brentford go I have them all from Samuel the Broker to the present day. One line to which I am related goes back to the East End of London and spread out from there. There are branches in Canada and Australia.. The family tree

books formidable but from a genealogical point of view
a start of 1800 is not much to enthuse over

From various pointers encountered during my research I have
got the notion that my Goddards originated from Wiltshire
Hence this letter to you. I read your ~~art~~ article in the Feb
issue of the F.T. mag. and apart from giving me enjoyment
it gave me the hope that you might have gone over the
same ground as myself and might be inclined to help me.
I have probed the Marylebone ~~end~~ end of the Brentford Goddards
and find no sign of a Samuel Goddard baptism or a
possible parentage. Nearest I got was a marriage -

Timothy Thomas - Kun Goddard 16 Jan 1798

A witness to the marriage was in Holland Goddard.

In the Brentford parish records there is an entry -

Privately baptised 5th Mar. 1800 John Holland-Goddard
Son of Samuel and Rebecca Goddard

With such a very unusual naming I should think there must be a
link somewhere - probably on the female side of a previous marriage.

When I complete my Goddard research, if you can use the word complete in
respect of Family History, I intend to produce it in book form. I have
unearthed a great deal of information so far, including some skeletons,
that will back up the family tree. This will be a private printing for
family circulation. I have done this twice before with books on
my wife's family and my parents families.

In the case of the Goddards, if there is any information there that
would interest, you are welcome to share it

Having read this far I hope you be able to offer some help. If I
were not so ancient I would be more mobile and net better folk
like you for assistance but anno domini has caught up for me and
I have to work from home. I look forward to hearing from you
and await the favour of your reply. S.a.c enclosed
