Dear David,

I have looked at your beautifully drawn chart, but cannot help you any further until I have checked several details.

You will see that there is a discrepancy in the details you give for William Goddard. I have marked the place. Also have you obtained William and Jane Maria Howard's marriage certificate? You can judge what years to look for it by the date of birth of their first child. Check the index for the years you think possible for both William Goddard and Jane Maria Howard until you find them both and an index number which agrees. Then order the certificate, either yourself or through an agent.

I have had a look at the 1881 census (the only one I have for Surrey and the London area) and there are certainly Goddards living in Worplesdon at that time:-

George Goddard aged 42 a brickburner with a wife named Rachel who is 33. Both were born in Worplesdon.

Thomas Goddard aged 44 a General Labourer born Guildford. His wife is Ellen aged 42, born in Worplesdon.

William Goddard aged 31 Living in Woking, born in Worplesdon. An agricultural carter. Wife Ann aged 21.

James Goddard aged 52 a Labourer born Compton, Surrey.

Might I request that you do not telephone your enquiries, but write instead. We have so much paperwork that I cannot put my hand on a specific document immediately, nor, often bring to mind a specific persons requirements in an instant, especially as we have at least three David Goddards as members.

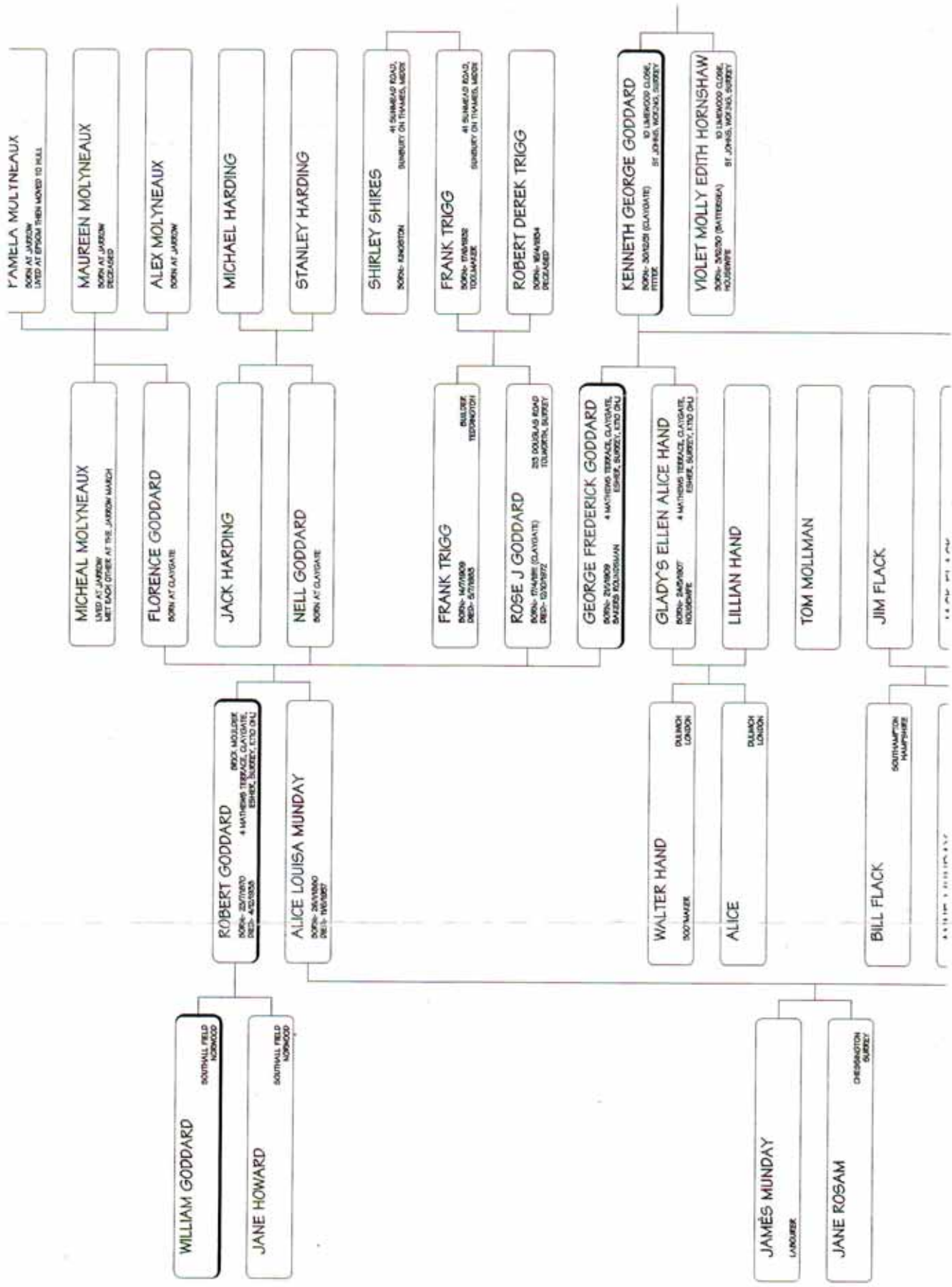

To answer your queries: We do not have a list of members names and addresses as such. Occasionally, under pressure, John the Treasurer runs off a computer list for John, Membership, Richard and me. As for e-mail addresses, as far as I know only Malcolm in Australia and Peter in Canada use them. Several have friends whose facilities they can use. Richard in Malvern still uses a fountain pen. The committee at its last meeting asked John, Membership to look into putting the GAE on the Internet. *I see in my last letter I suggested that the William Goddard you wanted was aged 40 and working as a general labourer, born in Brentford, but I now offer you the alternative:
[it shows that I shouldn't believe the notes of other people]*

In the 1881 census of Middlesex, at 10 Wrights Cottages, Acton were

William Goddard, Head of household, aged 48, Married, a General Labourer, born in Guildford, Surrey.

Jane, his wife, aged 40, born in Woking in Surrey

Elizabeth, his daughter, born in Poole, Dorset

Arthur, his son, aged 16, a general labourer born Kent, Mark Cross

Robert, his son, aged 11, at school born in Southall, Middlesex

Amos, his son, aged 9, at school, born Lancashire, Appleton

Richard, his son, aged 4, born in Shepherds Bush

It looks as if the family had moved around the country in search of work.

In the I.G.I. for Surrey

William Goddard married **Jane Howard** at Woking St John the Baptist on 10 July 1859

Thomas Goddard married **Mary Patrick** 21 Nov 1824 Guildford St Mary

William son of **Thomas** and **Mary** baptised 28 August 1831 Guildford St Nicholas

Thomas son of ditto baptised 15 Dec 1833 ditto

I didn't look for other children, there may have been more.

Does this look more like your family?

I think that now you have to expand the above details; get the essential certificates to find addresses and trades. I will let you know if I discover anything further, or have anyone write in with information.

Dear Mr Goddard,

I have now found the correspondence relating to your former enquiry.

In the 1881 census your ancestor, William, was aged 40 and working as a general labourer. His wife's name was Jane and she was 40 also. Both were born in Brentford. I have sent for a full print out of the entry as enumerated and will send it to you as soon as it arrives.

I have a brief reference, sent in by someone else, that in the 1891 census William's wife's name is given as Jane Maria and she is a year older than William, he being born in 1841 and she in 1840.

I have looked in the I.G.I. for London but cannot find William's baptism or his marriage. It looks as if you are going to have to do your research the hard way and search the Register of Births, Marriages and Deaths for a William Goddard who married a Jane around 1860 somewhere in London (we can fix the date of the marriage a little more closely when we get the 1881 census details and see how old their children were), or a William Goddard born in 1841, or late 1840 in Brentford. Unfortunately it is more than likely that there is more than one William Goddard born at that time in that area. There was certainly a John Goddard, born 1836 in Brentford, a general dealer who married Helen. He might be a brother of your William.

There are no other members of the Goddard Association who have told me that they have ancestors born in Brentford, but I do have a contact who can perhaps help. I will also have a note concerning your ancestry put in the Goddard Newsletter.
