Following the recent November Newsletter from "The Goddard Association of Europe", I see that the Middlesex 1881 Census list of Goddards is now "in stock"! I have been trying to trace my Maternal Grandmother (Maria Amelia Goddard) since before the G.A.E. was formed - but with no luck.

Sadly, my Mother (Elsie Amelia Dunn Cunningham) died in October of this year, however I would still like to continue my search. I have enclosed all the B.M. & S. certificates I have relating to this London branch of the Goddards, & wonder if there is anything in the 1881 census that ties in?

Interestingly, in the previous Newsletter (August '96), a new Member from Tasmania, Mr. Beverley Watson also has London ancestors - in Marylebone, like mine, and even a cab driver Goddard - again, just like mine!

Of course in this area of research there must be many similar instances as this - & London is

a big city too!

Maybe you could look out for Mrs. Watson's ancestors at the same time, since I would like to write to her with my information & see if any of the jig-saw pieces fall into place at all.

Strangely, there was a little family legend that "our" Goddards left England & possibly for Australia; certainly, I have not been able to get a death cert. yet of ^{maria} Amelia Cunningham (nee Goddard) - or even a Birth Cert., either in Scotland or England, despite searches.

Anyway, I hope you might be able to come up with a little bit more detail for me. I only hope you haven't been inundated with requests like mine, & may I thank you in advance for your time & trouble.

Dear Mr Nolan,

I am sorry to have kept you waiting for an answer to your enquiry. I have now been able to consult the 1881 census for Middlesex, which includes St Marylebone.

There is an entry for

I suggest that you write to

R.Kent, 4 Torridge Road, Keynsham, Bristol BS18 1QG

and ask for a print out of the census in the way that the enumerator took it down. The reference number will give him the folio and sheet. This will give you the names of everyone at that address. Have a close look at any lodgers and the people living next door or upstairs in case they are relatives. The cost will be about 25p a sheet.

There are 42 pages of Goddards living in Middlesex in the 1881 census. Why not write to the new lady in Tasmania and compare notes. I have just received back the files of papers and records from the two ladies who were going to take over the research and am having to try to discover what has been done. As I handed the papers over because I had too much to do with looking after my family plus free lance work of my own, I am having to cut back severely on what I can do for the association.

Having found the address for George's fishmonger business I suggest that you consult the Westminster Libraries (now including St Marylebone). You can find the address from your local library. They have vast records of trade directories and could tell you how long George was there etc. You could even find that they had a picture of the street where he lived.
