Indeed it was. Frank died early this year as you probably know.

His dad was Frederick Cyril Goddard and as big a rogue as you're likely to find. He committed bigamy shortly after Frank was born and got 9 months for that. Frank's mother divorced him in 1927 at which time he was a guest of H.M. in Maidstone Prison for an offence about which I am not altogether sure since he was in the habit of using various aliases. But I think it was for having carnal knowledge of a young girl under the name BORST. This is certainly a name he used once before when he got sent down for stealing

One thing I was never able to pin down was when and where F.C. was born. He changed his age a lot and all I can say is that he was born between 1890 and 1895. At one trial he was described as a native of Faversham.

Just before Frank died I had discovered that F.C. was described as "of the R.A.F. Uxbridge" at one of his trials. Unfortunately his file, although listed, was missing from the PRO as was another file in the name of Frederick BORST. I had attempted to get something out of the RAF Records Office but they wanted an application from the Next of Kin. Shortly before Frank died I emailed him giving him the details of where to apply but he probably did not do so.

Frank's son Neil advised me of his father's death and I decided to drop things for a few months. At one point I asked Frank if he had passed on all the details of his father's nefarious past to his children but he told me he had not done so for fear of upsetting them. By now they may have found out.

I tried all sorts of angles to find FC's birth including the idea that he might not have been a Goddard but a Borst. I got his military record - that didn't help. I tried fitting him into Goddard Faversham families - that didn't work either. Unfortunately these days I just don't have the time to devote to pursuing these enquiries to the nth degree, but maybe Neil might want to take up where I left off.

FREDERICK GODDARD
1893/4

Native of Faversham, Kent. August 7th 1914 he joined the R.A.S.C.. While in the army he was court martialled for theft and absence without leave. After serving his sentence he was discharged. He re-enlisted but then deserted.

There were four previous convictions and three outstanding warrants against him:
one for stealing a bicycle at Maidenhead
another for stealing another bicycle at Beaconsfield
shopbreaking at Henley.

From report of *Quarter Sessions 1922*

He had also been convicted of wife desertion, bigamy and larceny.

Reading Standard April 29 1922

Frederick Goddard aged 27, engineer of no fixed abode, and **Robert Chapman** aged 18, labourer charged with breaking into the office of Charles Thomas Honey, "The Star" offices, and stealing two pairs of boots and other articles. Other report details these as one bottle of whisky, a cheque book, 250 cigarettes and a brown leather bag, a mackintosh, an overcoat and a cap to the total value of £8 10s.

Statement by Chapman co-defendant, that after the burglary at "The Star" offices on February 10/11th. they stayed at 7 Bryanstone Square until the following Monday.

A landlady at Theale said that the two prisoners spend the night at her house, saying that they were engaged in road repairs on the Bath Road. They left without paying her, and left behind the bag, a jemmy and the overcoat mentioned in the charge.

Chapman says that they walked to Maidenhead where Goddard stole the bicycle. They paid for lodgings with the cheque money. Then they broke into Colnbrook station and Chapman stole the bike. They were arrested at Cheapside.

Goddard was also charged with breaking into empty houses in Clifton Road on February 5th and stealing with **Ernest William Wells**, one bevel, two locks, one bradawl, two locks, one saw set, four bead planes, a tape measure, three chisels and two distemper brushes from a workman's locked shed, to the total value of £4. The three chisels were found in the lodgings at Theale.

Wells said that he only went along with it because Goddard had threatened him with a revolver. He had known Goddard since he bigamously married his sister.

Goddard pleaded guilty.

Goddard, previous convictions, sentenced to three years penal servitude.

Chapman sent to gaol for six months with hard labour

Wells was said to have been discharged from the army as feeble minded and was put on probation for twelve months.
