Thank you for your letter and print out of the 1881 Census.

My wife Sharon and I have had a good look at the information provided and as well as talking to other family members.

We think that the Goddard family on page 27, folio 80 who lived in Old Market St are my Great, Great Grandparents, and that the Goddard's on page 16, folio 56 who lived in Old Meeting Lane are my Great, Great, Great Grandparents,

There is also James Goddard Page 25, folio 79, 49 Old Market Street This person could have been my Great, Great, Great Grandfathers Son.

We have also found that James had several brothers and sisters possibly up to 7 or 8.

Thetford Today is in Norfolk but that has only been since the boundary changes in the late 1960's or 70's. Before then Thetford was divided by the river so some was in Norfolk and some in Suffolk.

We are not aware if my family non conformists- chapel or Quaker.

Thank you once again for the information you have provided, it has been a great help and has given us something to start with.

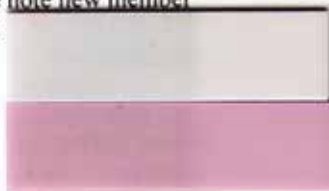

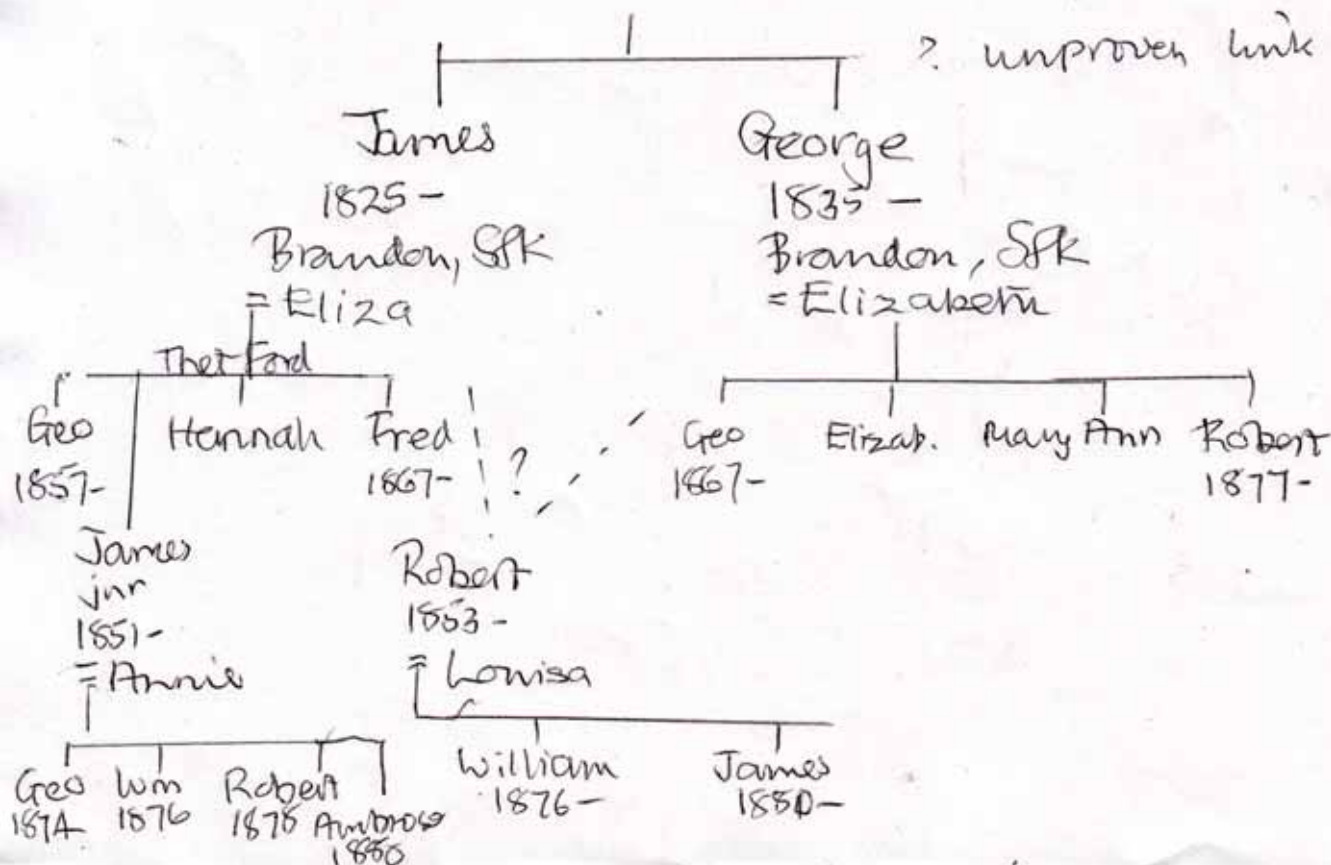

Dear Patrick,

## Goddards of Thetford

Welcome to the Goddard Association.

I have had a look through our Goddard file for Norfolk and Suffolk and especially Thetford. One of our long standing members thought twelve years ago that his ancestors came from Thetford and were the fishmongers in the Market Place. I have written to ask how much further he has got with his tree - though it is not necessarily the same as yours as there have been several different Goddard families moving into and out of Thetford over the centuries.

I enclose the entries from the 1881 census which I think are your family. I suggest that James senior and George are brothers, but they could be cousins. Robert could be the son of either James or George, and James junior likewise.

I always thought that Thetford was in Norfolk. My father came from East Harling and went to Thetford on the bus one day when staying with our grandparents. However, I see that in some of the genealogical records it is said to be in Suffolk. I think that your next step should be to look at the records for Brandon for the baptisms of James in 1825 and George in 1835 - unfortunately both were born before 1837 after which date births were registered at the Public Record Office independently of baptism in church or chapel. Do you know if the family were nonconformists - chapel or Quaker?

Please do get back to me for any advice on how to proceed further. I suggest also that if you are beginners that you have a look at a copy of the magazine *Practical Family History* which you should find in W. H. Smiths, which is aimed at beginners and has lots of good advice. Its sister magazine *Family Tree Magazine* is aimed at more advanced family historians, but is equally readable.

Goddards of Norfolk

I see from the February Goddard Newsletter you are researching your Goddards in Norfolk. I have looked through our big file of people who are researching in Norfolk for you and at this moment we do not have anyone with an ancestry that looks like yours in the Loddon area. Of course, if we do not have member's family trees on file we cannot put other researchers in touch with them if a match does turn up. Pooling researches and family memories often leads to great advances.

One member, Mrs Anne Hockaday, has written to me saying that she has spotted something which might be of interest to you. She says that in the 1861 census of Portsmouth, at 46 Arundel St., there is a Charlotte Goddard, head, widow, aged 72 who was born at Wickhampton, Norfolk. Her grandchildren Walter and Harriet Blanchard, and Henry and William Goddard were staying with her. The grandchildren were born around Portsmouth. As Anne writes, Wickhampton is not far from Loddon.

I am not sure from the Newsletter whether there is a misprint and it should read "Stepney, London".
