Hi Julie,

I have just received a card from Denise to say that you had found James Parfitt 29.10.1868 at the same time that I have now received his Birth Certificate which has NO father registered. However I have also received the marriage certificate of James Goddard & Jane Parfitt married 17 April 1870 @ St. Peters Church, Walworth, Newington, Surrey. There appears to be quite a gap between the birth of James Parfitt & their marriage so can we presume he was their offspring or had Jane got pregnant by someone else?

Jane Parfitt's father was William Parfitt living 2 Railway Cottages - Cab driver. James Goddard was living 4 Railway Cottages certificate witnessed by Robert & Elizabeth Goddard

I have received an extensive amount of information from Denise & that was how I was able to send for the certificates. I have now found a death entry for Jane Goddard age 28 1879 June Qtr St. Saviour 1d 14 so will be sending for this copy. I cannot find a marriage for Sarah Nevell/Neville & James Goddard!!! I shall be writing to Denise in due course but have been trying to sort out all my papers. I did send a message on Curious Fox & have had a message from Carol Nubbert who is descended from Alfred Goddard. No further information regarding our side!

There is definitely a James on my Tree, and I obtained their daughter's birth certificate (Mary Louisa) giving mother's maiden name as Parfitt. So it all ties in.

I found James son of John and Jane baptised in Carleton Rode 23.8.1846.

This was the one who I then found in the 1881 and 1891 at 57 park street.

Unfortunately I haven't got my full tree here so can't be more precise at this stage.

It could be another James, in which case I have got my census data wrong as well, but I'm pretty sure I'm right.

They may have looked through the Bunwell stuff but as the chap that is there (and the one who takes your money off you) he hasn't really got much idea, and as John lived in Carleton Rode all his life, but was baptised and buried in Bunwell, he should have suggested there.

They may well want to be descended from landed gentry - but I'm not convinced; they'll need to prove otherwise!

Dear Julie

Thank you for your recent letter. I was very pleased to see that you have been contacted by Carol Nubbert, but as yet have not been contacted by her.

As you can see I have made some progress with the family tree. I was waiting until I went back to Norfolk again to do a bit more research and visit the vicar at Bunwell, to get the Parish records. I hoped to give you a complete tree with all the bits filled in. Anyway, this is it so far.

Thank you for the census data. I went to London and had a few problems because as you can see Alfred Goddard moved around a lot. The census address of Foulmin Street is also incorrect, as no such street exists. Eventually, after several cross checks, I found it was Toulmin Street.

I was going to discuss several things with you at the Annual General Meeting, before I carry on and spend a few more days in Norfolk. I seem to be coming to a dead end as there seem to be no other Goddards in Bunwell or Aslacton other than my direct relatives (ie no extended family), I assume they come from the surrounding area, but other than looking through every village's records, I'm not sure what else I can do. I have also contacted the oldest relative in South Africa with a list of questions (as I would like to write up our branch of the tree). To date she has not replied, but perhaps I can pick your brains a bit in May?

I enclose the army records of Walter White Goddard. I was told my great grandfather Walter William was in the Grenadier Guards. I sent for the only W W Goddard, who wasn't actually any relation. If someone would find them of interest please pass them on.

Goddard's in Depwade

John Goddard born circa 1795 within Norfolk.

As per the 1841 census John and his wife Mary who was born circa 1800 lived in Hempnall or Hempnall Green. John was a labourer and they had 4 children.

Mary Anne born circa 1822

Maria born circa 1828

Richard born circa 1830

James born circa 1832

On the 14<sup>th</sup> December 1857 James married Eliza Brooks at the parish church in Hempnall. Eliza's father was Charles Brooks and both families lived in Hempnall although Eliza was born in Tacolnstone in 1835. Charles occupation was labourer (I believe both were Farm labourers).

By the 1861 census there were no Goddard's in Hempnall.

James and Eliza were now living in the Hamlet of Wood Green (no. 65) in the parish of Stratton St Mary (Long Stratton) and James was a farm labourer.

James and Eliza had 4 children

Mary born 1860

James born 1862

Ellen born 1868

John born 1879

On the 14<sup>th</sup> November 1884 James married Mary Ann Hunt at the parish church of now Long Stratton. Mary's father was Isaac Hunt and his occupation was a farm labourer. Both families lived within the parish. Mary was born in 1866.

On the 28<sup>th</sup> July 1904 John married Annie Rowell at the Independent church Stratton St Mary. John occupation was Bricklayer / Journeyman and he lived in Stratton St Michael. Annie's father was William Rowell whose occupation was Coal miner. Annie lived in Stratton St Mary and was born in 1882.

By the 1891 census James (occupation Farm labourer) was living with his wife Mary at no. 65 Wood Green and his mother Eliza together with John had moved to Star Lane in Stratton St Michael.

James and Mary had (I believe) only 3 children

Arthur Fredrick born 13<sup>th</sup> January 1885

Ellen born 1888

Bessy born 1890

Arthur Fredrick trained as a carpenter in Long Stratton but left and joined the Metropolitan Police in 1906.

Ellen married Henry Arthur Buck on the 10<sup>th</sup> September 1910 at the parish church of Tharston. Henry was a farm labourer and was born in 1889 – his father was also Henry Arthur Buck and they were from Tharston.

On the 25<sup>th</sup> December 1910 Arthur married Lily Maud Cook at the parish church of St Saviour, Brixton Hill in London. Arthur was living in Edmonton, North London and was serving in the Kings Cross area of London. Lily's father was John Cook and his occupation was a milkman. Lily was born on the 26<sup>th</sup> July 1887 in Brixton.

Arthur and Lily had 4 children

Arthur Fredrick died on the 7<sup>th</sup> March 1927 in Edmonton and Lily Maud died in Paddington on the 9<sup>th</sup> July 1934 – both are buried in Cheshunt, Hertfordshire.

Arthur Cyril married Dorothy Frances Winch-Furness in Enfield, North London in 1937. Dorothy was born in Enfield in 1912. Arthur's occupation was a maintenance engineer, although he had many jobs. Arthur and Dorothy spent nearly all their married life in Enfield and Arthur died on the 6<sup>th</sup> July 1999 aged 87 the eldest of all the children but had outlived them. His wife Dorothy and his 4 surviving children survive him.
