Mary Ann GODDARD m. James TINGEY 4/6/1869. They are my paternal great grandparents. On the census of 1881, they are living in Wereham, Norfolk. They are not be found in Wereham, or in any of the nearby villages, in the 1871 census for this area of the Clackclose Hundred. Possibly they were still in Ely.

Also, I am presuming that Burgess is a brother. He is first seen on the 1881 census living - with his wife Louisa and two children, Florence Alberta and Hilda Gertrude - with who I presume is his sister and her husband, Maria and David MURFITT.

Your mail came in as I was busy on my one to you.

Are you aware as to whether Burgess is a common name, for I have *another* Burgess GODDARD, that I received from a GODDARD lady, living in Canada. She even sent me a picture of him, but I worked out that he could not possibly be the Burgess GODDARD that I was looking for in my family, as the picture would have been at least 30 years out in time. Her information, she said, was taken from the census of 1891 and this is what she gave me:

James Goddard child of Burgess Goddard & unknown lady (on marriage cert. he is listed as a cook and "full age")

Alice Saunders child of Wm. Saunders (farmer) & unknown lady (on marriage cert. she is spinister)
They were wed on Jan. 11, 1876 at which time Burgess was dead and place of event was Doddington

Together they had: (Age listed was at 1891 census with residence on Catherine Street, St. Andrew the Less, Cambridge)

Mary Ann 15 (she later changed her name to Sarah Ann)
Mabel Minnie 11
Ethel 9 (could be Edith Lillian as another record indicates this)
Sidney J. 7
Eleanor A. 5
William H. 3
Burgess 4 months.

This was her information. If this of no interest for you to check, please don't worry.

My grandfather also had Burgess appear in his name: Thomas Burgess TINGAY (born TINGEY, but found on the Commonwealth War Graves site as TINGAY, as am I). Maybe this was tradition, but it has carried no further than my grandfather.

Thank you so much for taking the trouble.

Dear Julie,

It appears to be ages since I was in contact with you altho' I find it was November!!!!

I was very fortunate in being able to speak with Denise & all the information that she gave me on the Goddard families. I sent her a whole load of information that I found but it would appear by the latest newsletter that you did not know that we had confirmed that Jane Parfitt was married to James Goddard on the 17 April 1870 at St. Peters Church, Walworth(cert. held)

James Parfitt was born to Jane Parfitt in the Union Workhouse, Christchurch, Surrey on the 29th Oct. 1868, no father entered on Cert. (cert. held)

One can only presume that it was James Goddard - The Brewer's son especially as he was named James!

Jane(Parfitt) Goddard died 3 May 1879 of Pthisis.(cert. held)

She was born 31 Dec. 1850 to William Barnett Parfitt (Horsekeeper) & Mary nee Pearson at 11 Vine Yard, Harrow Street, Southwark (cert.held)

I have searched for the marriage of James Goddard - The brewers 2nd marriage to Sarah who had a daughter Mary Nevell (1881 census) but have been unable to find it. Maybe they didn't marry but only lived together!!

It would appear that when Jane Parfitt married James Goddard that her son was then called James Parfitt Goddard. J.P.Goddard married Elizabeth Harriet Wild 26 July 1891 (cert.held)

They had 2 sons James Goddard birth date not yet confirmed & William Charles Goddard who married Alice Beatrice Ailles 12 June 1920. They had 2 sons

Alan Parfitt Goddard born 13th Sept. 1924 married Cynthia Aerial Cranmer (myself).

Keith Roger Goddard born 10 Aug. 1929 married Marion Hayter.

Dear Mr Goddard

Thank you so much for your letter. I do hope we can share our research and are able to help each other, especially as I have been stuck for many years now searching for the baptism of a William Goddard, who was born 1759/61. My earliest record is the marriage of William Goddard (he died in Heckingham, Norfolk, 1841 and was buried in Aldeby, Norfolk), so I shall give a brief account of the information I have obtained. I have used capital letters to show the line of descent.

WILLIAM GODDARD married Ann Spalding 1783, in Aldeby, Norfolk. WILLIAM GODDARD, widower, married Ann Alkins 1788. They had the following children, all baptised in Aldeby, Norfolk. Maria bp 1789, WILLIAM bp 1791, Rachel bp 1792, George bp 1797, Eleanor bp 1802, Martin bp 1804 and John bp 1807.

WILLIAM GODDARD married Phebe Barber 1810 at Kirkley Parish Church, Suffolk and they had the following children, all baptised in Lowestoft, Suffolk. George 1810, William bp 1812, Eleanor bp 1814, Caroline bp 1816 and died 1816, William bp 1817 and CHARLES FREDERICK, born 1820 and baptised 1827.

CHARLES FREDERICK GODDARD married Elizabeth Drew at St Leonards Church, Shoreditch, London, 1840. I have found my family of Goddards on the 1841-1891 census and they lived in Stepney, Mile End Old Town, West Ham and Kensington.

It would be great if you have come across any of my family during your research, or may be I can help you in some way as I have accumulated quite a lot of information on Goddards over the years.

Census Information

Following a recent newsletter, I understand that you do have copies of some census information. I have reached a bit of a dead end tracing the Goddard side of my family.

My great grandfather Walter William Goddard was born on 20.12.1884 in Southwark, Surrey. His father was Alfred Goddard (an engineer's turner) and mother Mary Ann Goddard nee Jarrett. The address at that time was 48 Oswin Street Southwark.

When I went to London and looked at the 1891 census there were no Goddards at that address, and in 1881 the house was not built. (Unless I can't see for looking!, and I missed something.)

The only further back I managed to get was the marriage certificate (from the St Catherine's index working back from the baptism date) of Alfred and Mary Ann Sophia Jarrett on 7.8.1882 at St Mary Knewington Surrey. I did go to another parish record office in London and hoped to find perhaps other brothers/sisters marriages around that time, but could not. Alfred's father is Robert and mother Mary.

By 1905 Walter got married in Cape Town and I have a tree of hundreds of other Goddards since then (copy enclosed). So I'm a bit stuck tracing things back. Can you give me any more help, perhaps from the census information.
