Thank you very much Julie for your letter (snail) which you sent after seeing my name in the "18th.Century Links" of Family Tree Magazine, that was very kind of you.

My Sarah GOTHARD married Charles SIDEBOTTOM at Wath upon Dearne in January 1775. I have three possibilities for her birth.

1. Sarah could have been bapt. 23 March 1761 of father Robert at Rotherham (this could have made her about 14 years old when she married assuming a bapt. shortly after birth).
2. However, the more likely (age wise ?) is, that Sarah GOTHARD was bapt. 9 Dec. 1750 with father being John at Silkstone near Barnsley.(this again assuming baptism to be near the birth).

Assuming for the moment that the Silkstone line is the one to follow I have found that :

John GOTHARD was b.1721 at Silkstone of father Francis.

Francis GOTHARD was b. 1692 at Silkstone of parents Francis and Ann nee WOODHEAD.

3. The 3rd. possibility of which I'm now about to discount is that Sarah GOTHARD was born of Benjamin and Susan. Benjamin was a nailer of Ashes / Ash House / Ashcroft which are locations in the village of Wentworth.

Of course Thorpe Hesley, Kimberworth, and Wentworth are just a couple of miles from each other, with Rotherham, Wath on Dearne and then Silkstone just a few miles further on, so the probability is that the GOTHARD families in this area were related.

Do hope to hear from you again Julie. Is the surname GOTHARD a localised variant of GODDARD ?

Dear Mr Flavell,

I have seen your name in the "18th Century Links" section of June issue of *Family Tree Magazine* as being descended from Sarah Goddard/Gotherd, daughter of Benjamin and Susan Goddard with Thorpe Hesley connections.

The name of Thorpe Hesley rang a bell and looking into our Goddard files I see that in July 1999 we had a letter from Mr Stuart Goddard of 12 Dimple Wells Close, Ossett, West Yorkshire, WF5 8JU, who is descended from Matthew Goddard (born c1839) who married Louisa Muscroft on 11th November 1888 at Wath upon Dearne. They appear to have lived in Thorpe Hesley, where Reece Goddard, Stuart's grandfather was born in 1883. In the 1881 census Matthew is listed as a coal miner aged 42, born Thorpe Hesley.

If you are pursuing this line of ancestry you might like to contact Stuart Goddard to see if you can help each other.

Dear Mr Goddard,

Thank you for your letter and brief family tree. I am afraid that I cannot say whether Mr J. Goddard of Doncaster, who died recently, was related to you as he never contacted me and therefore I have no knowledge of his family tree. I do not know if his widow will remain a member.

I have had a look at the 1881 census for Yorkshire and abstracted the Goddards who lived in the Kimberworth area, which includes Thorpe Hesley. You will see that it shows the elder children of Mathew and Louisa, the ones born before your ancestor Reece. And that Mathew was born in 1839 or 1840 and Louisa in 1844 or 5 and therefore you can obtain their birth certificates [hoping that they were registered at birth as all those born after 1837 were supposed to be]. Or you can look at the parish registers of Thorpe Hesley and Stubbin for any baptism records. Mathew and Louisa's parents should be named on their marriage certificate which you appear to have. It may be that Mathew, James and Thomas are brothers and that Ann Goddard, the widow aged 64 in 1881 was their, or just Mathew's mother, as you say that is her name.

I do not have the 1851 census records of Yorkshire, but I am sure that your largest local library will have a copy which you can consult on microfiche or microfilm. John Goddard, our membership secretary (address in Accrington on the back of the Newsletter) is more conversant in the library facilities of the north than me. Ask him if you want any information in that direction. Please let me know what you discover so that I can put it in our files here and notify you if anyone else with the same ancestry contacts me.

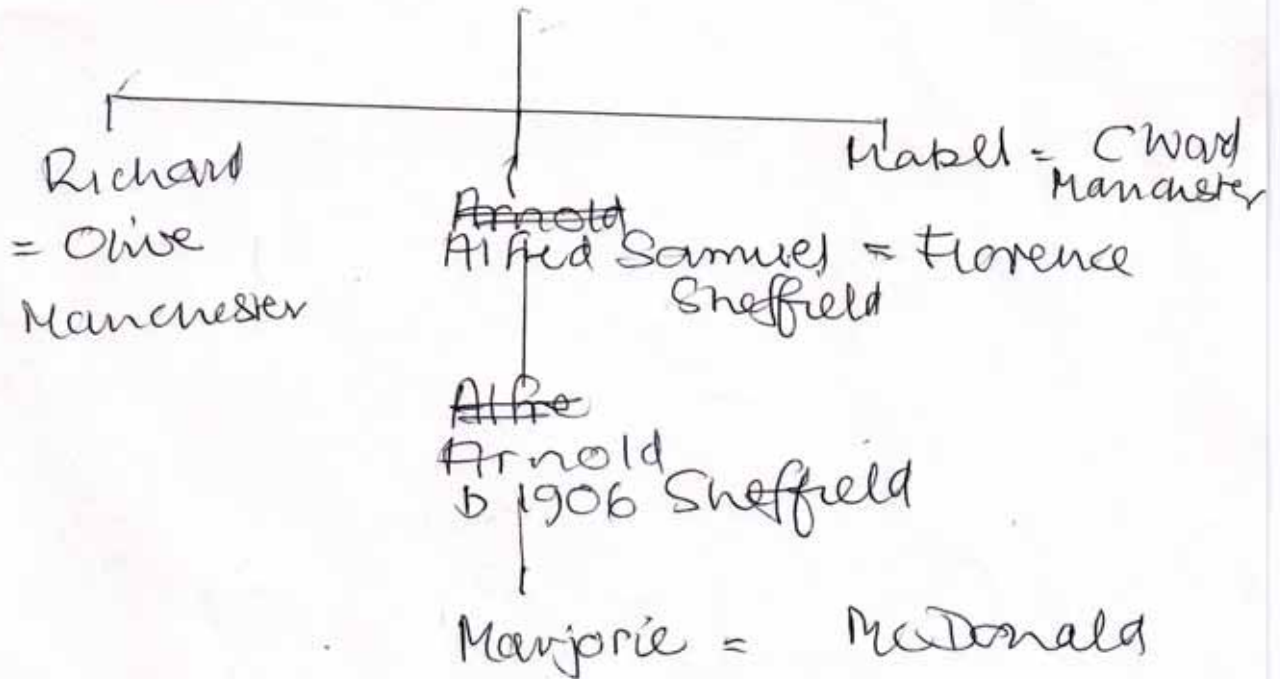
