My Goddards originate from Yorkshire and are mentioned in the 1841 Census Ref. HO 107-1327 page 14 No 12 Benjamin Goddard married a Margaret (unknown). First child mentioned in baptism records that I can find was Sarah of Ecclesfield in 1821. In family there is a record of Charles but no baptism that I can find he would be b ca 1820. He appears in Census for 1841 but not in later ones as he was transported to Tasmania in 1843. He had in Chapeltown in the township of Ecclesfield the following sisters Mary, Elizabeth, and brothers John & Benjamin.

The Father of Benjamin (married to Margaret was a John G. b 1774 Chapeltown who m a Mary (unknown) who d in 1810.

Do you have any records of these Goddards in your files please? The name Parkin comes through our Family, both my Father and Uncle had the middle name 'Parkin' but I am not sure where it has come in.

I would be pleased to hear from you with any information we can exchange

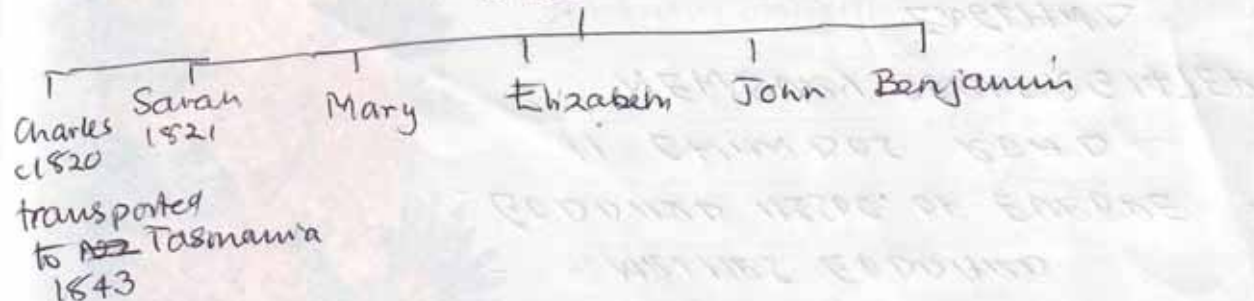

coming up on the I.G.I.

my family, the Gothards (or Goddard?)
are my first interest, if only to prove my
name was correct in what she said.
