The second son, Anthony Goddard, on the death of his brother, succeeded to the estates of his father, of which he sold that of Cowich to Mr. Northey in 1720. He m. Mary, daughter of Arthur Evans, esq. and had issue,
I. Richard, who succeeded him.
I. Mary, m. Charles Dewell, (Dr. Timothy Dewell, rector of Lydiard Tregose, in the county of Wilts, m. first, Elizabeth, daughter of Roger Knight, esq. of Greenham, in the county of Berks, and by her had issue five children. He m. secondly, Anne, daughter of Anthony Sannders, and by her had issue five sons, of whom the above Charles Dewell was one. Dr. Dewell was rector of Lydiard forty-two years; he died 07 May 1692.-(From an inscription in the chancel of Lydiard church).) of Malmesbury, by whom, who d. in Jamaica, she had a son, Timothy Dewell, who m. Elizabeth Jenkyns, and had issue,
1. Charles Dewell.
2. Henry Dewell.
3. Arthur Dewell.
4. Thomas Dewell, who m. first, Charlotte, daughter of Thomas Gaisford, esq. of Iford, in the county of Wilts, who died without issue. He m. secondly, 16 Nov 1830, Henrietta - Susanna, daughter of Colonel Tufnell, of Sydney Place, Bath. He resides at Dauntsey House, in the county of Wilts.
The only son,
Richard Goddard, M.D. succeeded his father in his estates at Purton, m. 01 Aug 1753, Sarah, daughter of the Right Hon. Sir John Willes, lord chief justice of the Common Pleas, and by her had issue an only daughter and heiress,

I believe the text above skips a generation and muddles the 2 Mary Goddards – but I can't prove this at present, but the dates don't work for me.
(Note: Charlotte Gaisford is also linked to Purton Goddards)

I have copies of the wills of Anthony Goddard and Richard Goddard. Anthony died before Mary's marriage, however Richard does mention his nephew Timothy Dewell of Malmesbury (m Elizabeth Jenkins) who is my 5G Grandfather

The following is an extract of the Dewell – Goddard linkage as I understand it currently – sources are indicated but more checks are needed to verify.:

First Generation

1 Timothy DEWELL, 5G Grandfather. Born in Malmesbury, Wilts in 1741.¹ Timothy was 51 when he died in Malmesbury Abbey, Wilts on 29 Jul 1792.^{2,3} aged 51. Occupation: Doctor of Physic. A copy of the will is available.

FILE [no title] - ref. 1461/1768 - date: 1 Apr. 1766

_ [from Scope and Content] Lease by Mary Dewell widow of Malmsbury and her son Timothy apothecary of Malmsbury to William Buy gent. of Eastcott: a messuage with 2a. of meadow in Eastcott alias Nethercott.

FILE [no title] - ref. 1461/1770 - date: 2 Apr. 1766
_ [from Scope and Content] Assignment by Thomas Vilett esquire of Swindon (at the direction of Timothy Dewell apothecary of Malmsbury) to John Hobbs victualler of Swindon of a mortgage, 20 July 1764) by Timothy Dewell to Thomas Vilett: a messuage etc. in Eastcott alias Nethercott, in trust to attend the inheritance of William Buy.

FILE [no title] - ref. 1461/1771 - date: 6 June 1766
_ [from Scope and Content] Lease by William Buy gent. of Eastcott and his wife Ann to Thomas Goddard esquire of Swindon and Thomas Strange grocer of Swindon: Down Hikes Hayes (or the Hill Ground); Culvering Close (or the Briers) in Eastcott; and the Paddock, all bequeathed by Richard Wayt to Ann wife of William Buy; and a messuage and two meadows in Eastcott, purchased from Mary Dewell.

On 4 Jan 1773 when Timothy was 32, he married Elizabeth JENKINS, 5G Grandmother, in Sherston Magna, Wilts.¹

3 Mary GODDARD, 6G Grandmother. Born in Purton, Wilts in 1717.³ Christened on 19 Jul 1718 in Purton, Wilts.¹ Mary was 86 when she died in Malmesbury, Wilts on 24 Aug 1803.³ A copy of the will is available.

In 1700 when Charles was 24, he married Mary GODDARD, 7G Grandmother, in Swindon.¹

5 Mary GODDARD, 7G Grandmother. Born in Swindon in 1674.¹ Mary was 58 when she died in Malmesbury, Wilts in 1732.³ Aged 58.

6 Anthony GODDARD, 7G Grandfather. Born in Purton, Wilts in 1676. Christened on 18 Apr 1676 in Purton, Wilts.¹ Anthony was 59 when he died in Purton, Wilts in 1735.² A copy of the will is available.

Will written in 1725 when children were minors; leaves estates in trust with friends Richard Goddard of Swindon and Arthur Evans of Haydon. Mary was alive and her brother John. Will was proved in 1735.

Anthony Goddard, on the death of his brother, succeeded to the estates of his father, of which he sold that of Cowich to Mr. Northey in 1720. He m. Mary, daughter of Arthur Evans, esq.⁴

Anthony married Mary EVANS, 7G Grandmother.

8 Dr Timothy DEWELL, 8G Grandfather. Born in Reading, Berks in 1617.¹ Timothy was 75 when he died in Lydiard Tregoze, Wilts on 7 May 1692. Buried on 16 May 1692 in Lydiard Tregoze, Wilts.⁵ Occupation: Curate of Rodbounne Cheney in 1639. Occupation: Rector of Lydiard Tregoze for 42 years. Member of the clergy. A copy of the will is available.

FILE [no title] - ref. 1461/1748 - date: 23 May 1692

_ [from Scope and Content] Lease by John Wild innholder of Cricklade St. Sampson and his wife Elizabeth to Timothy Dewell gent. of Liddiard Millicent: 2 houses etc. with 6a of land in Eastcott or Nethercott.

Rev. Timothy Dewell, recotr of Lydiard Tregoze, he was presented in 1645 and Rector till his death in 1692. He was one of the Wiltshire Signatures to the testimony of ministers in 1648, and a non-conformist. He had his sympathies with Presbyterianism, and on very friendly terms with his patron, Sir Walter and Lady St. John of Lydiard park. When some of the St. John children were ill with smallpox, they were sent to lodge with Dr. Dewell and his wife at Lydiard.

Timothy wrote his will on the forth of June 1689 in Lydiard Tregoze. While not an extremely long will, he did mention many of the individuals and palaces. He first mentions his eldest son Thomas Dewell who receives lands in Southapton county and lands called Cardinalls Hat in Reading, Berkshire, seven acres of meadow in the Kings Meade and his house in Reading. His son Timothy received lands in Eastcott Westcott and Nerthcott in Swindon parish. Anthony Dewell his son was willed land in Lydiard Millicent. His youngest sons Richard and Charles received land in Burton. He also mentioned his wife Anne and some grandchildren a brother named Richard, some cousins, a brother-in-law named Mr. Johnathan Rogers a son in law Mr. Charles Vilett. But most important to Henry who was to be paid "one hundred pounds after the decease of my wife Ann Dewell" by his son Timothy.

According to "Burkes Commoners" Dr. Timonty Dewell, rector of Lydiard Tregoze, in the county of Wilts. M(arried) first Elizabeth, daughter of Roger Knight, esq. Of Greenham, in the County of Berks, and by her had issue five children. he m(arried) secondly, Anne, daughter of Anthony Saunders and by her had issue five sons, of whom the Charles was one. Dr. Dewell was rector of Lydiard forty two years; he died 7th May 1692.

9 Anne SAUNDERS, 8G Grandmother. Born in Pangbourne, Berks in 1633. Christened on 16 May 1633 in Pangbourne, Berks.¹ Anne was 78 when she died in Lydiard Tregoze, Wiltshire on 2 Apr 1711.¹ Buried on 5 Apr 1711 in Lydiard Tregoze, Wiltshire.

12 Francis GODDARD, 8G Grandfather. Born in 1639. Francis was 62 when he died in Little Somerford, Wilts on 22 Oct 1701.⁷ Aged 62, of Purton. Occupation: Of Purton and Cowich.

Francis Goddard, esq. second son of Francis Goddard, of Standen-Hussey and Cliffe-Pypard, (see page 325), succeeded his father in an estate called Cowich, near Calne, in 1652, land which had been alienated from the church in the time of King Henry VIII. He is stated in old papers to have had in his possession "a license of alienation from Sir John Williams to John Goddard of the said estate, dated iiii^o year of Edward VI." "and a fine and deed of the xxxi^o of Queen Elizabeth, that declares the uses thereof to Thomas Goddard,"

son of John Goddard , of Standen-Hussey , and grandfather of Francis . That part of the estate called Attrels , situate in Hilmarton and Calne , was purchased afterwards in xxix James I. He resided on his estate at Purton , having married, in 1667 , Elizabeth , Thomas Thorner , esq. by whom he had issue, ⁴

Manor of Standen Hussey in Hungerford (Berkshire) was sold in 1692.⁸

In 1667 when Francis was 28, he married Elizabeth THORNER, 8G Grandmother.
