Dear Mrs Gash,

I have permission from Alan Wright's son to pass on his family tree to you. He is apparently on an extended holiday and will not be back until December.

However, looking at the tree he has compiled I see that while you are related it is back in the 1770s. I am not clear from Alan's tree whether he thinks that William Goddard, born 1759, married twice firstly to Sarah Wilson, who died 1785, and then about 1789 to Mary Reynolds are the same person. Mary already had a son, Samuel born 1788 who took the surname of Goddard, whether or not because he was William's son it would be difficult to say. I am sending you copies of the first two pages of Mr Wright's 13 page tree. Do let me know if you want the remainder.
