The Will of William Goddard of Brook in the Parish
of Westbury in the County of Wiltshire Farmer

Son James Goddard
brother John Goddard
appointed Trustees & Executors.

"empower to carry on my farming and grazing
business and for that purpose to continue tenants
of the farm which I shall use at my decease
or to hire and use any other farm and employ my
live and dead agricultural stock...-

"to manage personal estate as appears most
advantageous and to sell or receive proceeds
to pay wife Martha all his income of 100 pounds
of personal estate to which I shall be entitled.

Provision made for children (sons under 21 and daughters
under 21 wife named)

To use £200 towards establishing each or any son
in a trade or business approved by the trustees

Any daughter who marries with the approbation of
the trustees is entitled to have £200 on marriage
(as part satisfaction of the share of her estate
to which she would be entitled - after decease of
her wife Martha?).

Will dated November 10 1860

Signed the mark of William Goddard

The Will of James Goodland late of Twyford Abbey Farm in the County of Middlesex Farmer, who died Nov. 7th 1877 at Twyford Abbey Farm was proved at the Principal Registry by Marika Goodland of Twyford Abbey Farm, widow his Relict and William Goodland of Drayton Green Farm in the Parish of Ealing in the said County, Farmers the Mother his Executors. Effects made £6000
- 1890 George Goodland of Mill Lane Greenford but late of 2 Waverick Villas Harwell, proved by Charlotte Goodland spinster his daughter of 2 Waverick Villas. (died Aug 5 1890)

now carried on by me at Wyke Green Farm,
Orlinden Park Inverurie aforesaid or any other
business in which I may be engaged at my
decease I empower the Trustees to continue
the name for so long as they shall think fit..."

The Trustees "during the life of my wife to have
entire control and management of business to
her and my son Frederick Richard.

Witnessed Samuel Litton Solicitor at his desk.

Note in 1893 but son

Frederick Richard was 18

Samuel died 1894 @ age 47

The Will of James Guddard of Tregford Allen
Farm, Farnham.

Dated November 1, 1877

Executor Wife Martha
 Frances William Guddard

After death his real estate leased and otherwise
with all livestock and crops. Current his money
interest and income to wife with personal effects.
After wife's death everything to be divided
equally between his children (not named)

James* died 1877 @ 44
age 44

Wife Martha Amelia died 1915 @ 82
see Will age 81
