Drayton Green Estate

On Monday Mr. Edward Millard offered at public auction at the Mart, Toker House Yard the important freehold building estate known as Drayton Green Farm. The property which includes the farmhouse homestead and land occupied by Mr. Samuel Goddard and an additional site of upwards of 24 acres making in all 90 acres was first offered as a whole but was not sold. It was then offered in two lots the portion left to Mr. Goddard being first submitted. No sale of either lot was effected.
