Dear Brian,

It was nice to talk to you and Julie on the 'phone today. I do hope your cold is better by the time you read this.

I enclose the disk with all the Goddard data, - I hope you will be able to read it alright. As I told you on the 'phone, the database has grown over the years, but a large input this year was all the Goddards on the Sussex Marriage Index. I had quite a lot of marriages already of course, but I was glad to get the rest! As 'my' Goddards originated in East Sussex, I have got more for that part of the county, than in the west. Having written that, though, apart from a nucleus of Goddards near the Kent border in the early records, I don't think that there are a lot of them over there! I have concentrated on the parishes which are not in the IGI.

Also included are the trees which I have been playing with, - it's quite fun putting them together, but as I have only done them from the records I have, the IGI and various censuses, they should not be read as gospel and should be well checked.

I have also included a tree which starts in the village of Stopham, and ends in Angmering. I am sure in my own mind that this is the origins of my husband's family, but try as I may, I cannot prove that the Robert who was born in Stopham was the one who settled in Angmering. The villages are fairly close, but he married by licence in Chichester, and there is no clue as to his origins. However, from then on Robert and Abigail are the gr-grandparents of James Goddard, who married Sarah Dyer on the 24th April, 1828 in Angmering, and I have already sent you details of their family. (If by chance you haven't got it, let me know and I will send you a copy.)

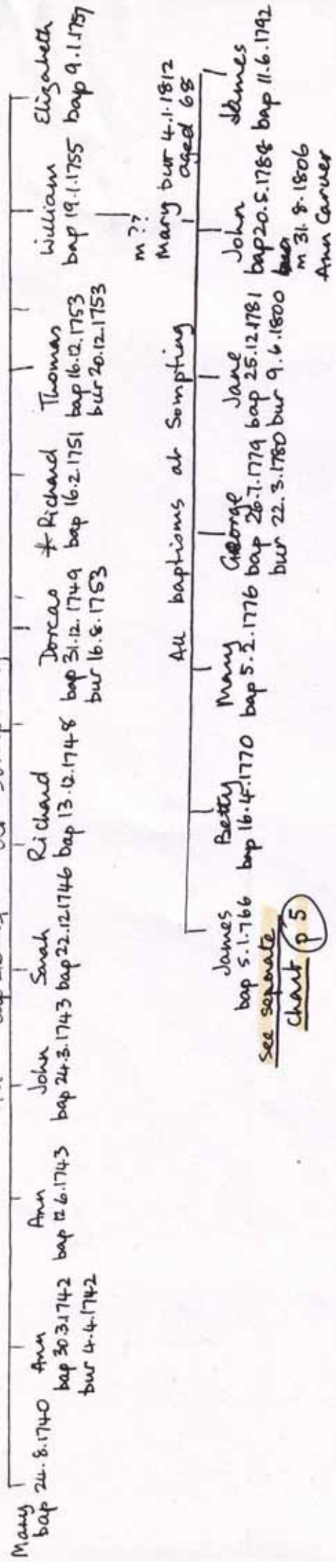

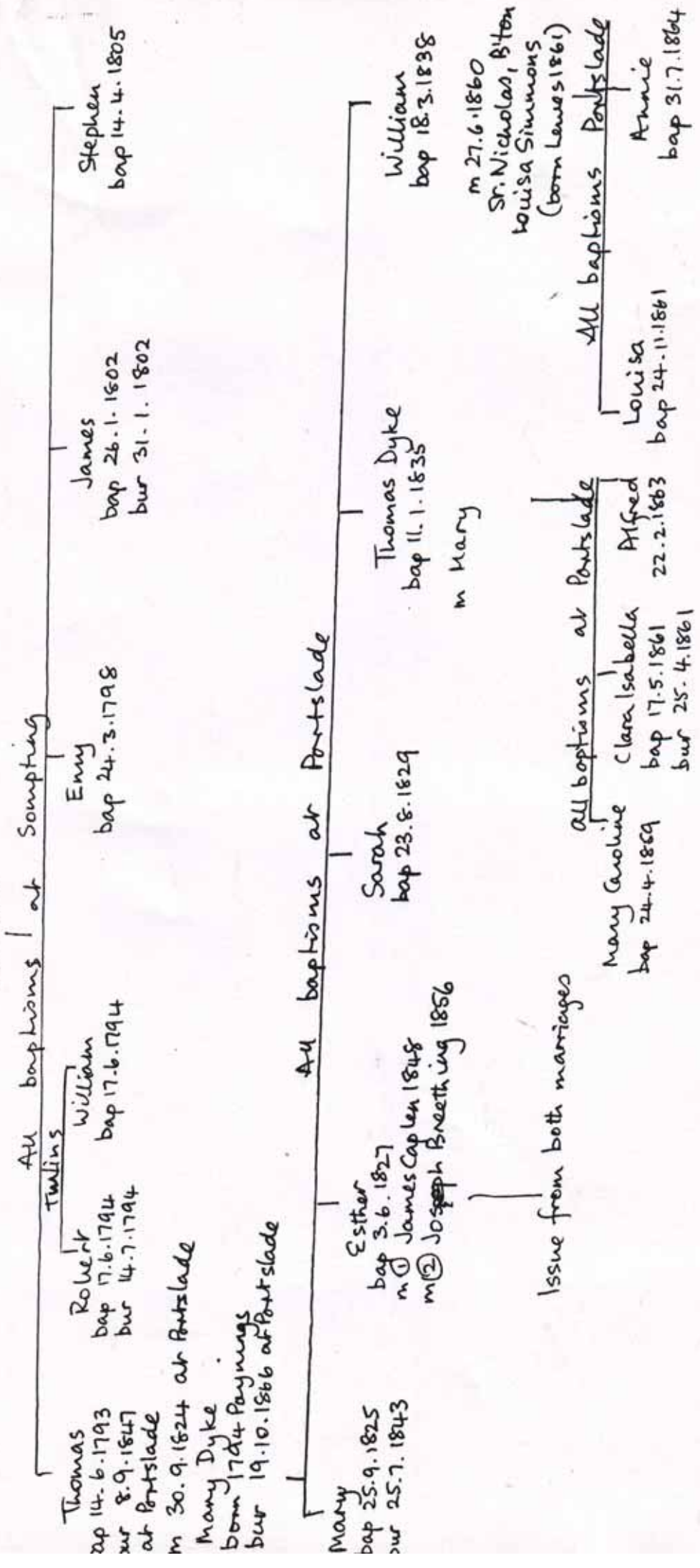
