Thank you for your Email.

The attachment is a report of the descendants of Thomas Goddard.

I have a problem finding the origins of Thomas, all the records I have found suggest he was the illegitimate son of a Elizabeth Goddard (Gotherd) and he was born at Wasperton about 1818, but on both his marriage certificates it states that his father was a John Goddard. He could have a brother William who was also the illegitimate son of Elizabeth Goddard, she was a servant in Warwick, but they were baptised at Wasperton. If Elizabeth is his mother, she could be the daughter of John Goddard and Mary Malins. I have not managed to find the Edward you think was his brother, but John Goddard and Mary Malins had son Edward, born in 1813.

The Harriet was his second wife a Harriet Standley of Warwick.


THE WARWICK GODDARDS
