Dear Julie,

I received your letter just after I had mailed mine to you.

Re enquiry about Thomas Berkley Goddard born in 1867 in Somerset to Thomas and Clara Goddard nee Marten

We have looked at the records we have for Somerset, also the 1881 census and the International Genealogical Index, but cannot find any record of Thomas, *born 1867 or 5 years either way.*

This is not to say that Thomas was not born then, just that we have no record of him. Does the enquirer have Thomas's birth certificate? If not and if she is sure of the birth date, it can be ordered for her. I think the latest cost is around £8.50, but I don't keep up to date with this sort of thing.

I am sending this to you, because if I wrote straight to the enquirer I would only have to write to you to say that I had done so. And goodness knows why (until I put my foot down) newspaper cuttings for the Newsletter were sent to me not Richard; and the same applies to queries to you not to the Research Co-ordination Dept.

Goddards of Axminster

Pardon me for my enthusiasm in telephoning to say that I had found your Goddard family in Axminster. If I didn't enjoy the excitement of the chase, I wouldn't have been unpaid research co-ordinator for the Goddards for twenty years!

I believe that you have print outs of the 1881 census showing your Goddards. If not I can provide them.

I have enclosed photocopies of the ownership of Inns in the Axminster area. I do not know what books, or books, they came from as they were done by Jim Goddard of Honiton, who covers the West Country Goddard research. It is his handwriting on the census document. Jim is a self-employed builder and does genealogical research in his free time.

Jim also found the following notes about Goddards

Removal orders (orders by parishes for the removal of anyone who belonged to another parish and whom they did not wish to be a burden on their rates. They were usually escorted on their way, on foot, by the parish constable.)

8 Feb. 1766 Removal from Membury to Axminster

James and Ann Goddard, with children James (13), Philip (8), Amily (6), Thomas (3).

29 July 1775 Removal of Philip Guathard from Membury to Axminster

2 August 1787 Removal from Bradlinch of Philip Gothard, found wandering and begging.

3 Feb. 1796 Removal from Membury to Uplyme. Hannah Goddard, is with child.

These are not necessarily from your family, but you might find they fit in somewhere.

Being in mind that you think that your ancestors were Roman Catholics, you might like to search the list of Recusants refusing to swear the Protestation Oath of 1642. I gather that Devon's copy is still extant in (I think) the Record Office in Exeter.

Your William, would I think the one who appears in the 1861 census aged 2, the son of William and Lavinia. As she came from Taunton it might be that they were married there, not in Axminster. On the other hand they could have been married at a Roman Catholic church near Axminster whose



records have not appeared in parish registers, nor in the I.G.I. (International Genealogical Index).

Do please get back to me when you have digested all this and if you need any help then I will try to assist.

My husband Brian says that he would like to take up your offer of looking in the London Museum for the Invitation to Goddards. Please contact him for further details.

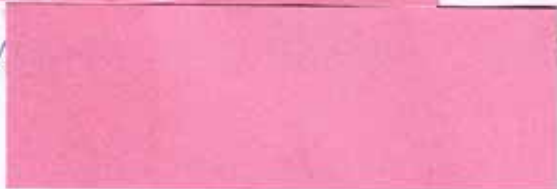
