Dear Mrs Goddard

I note from the Family Tree Magazine that you collect information on GODDARDs. Although my link is somewhat remote I am interested in a Jane GODDARD who married John CALL (a brother of my Great-grandmother) at St Mary's Church, Melcombe Regis, Weymouth, Dorset on 26 June 1844. Jane was the daughter of William GODDARD, a labourer, and was born at Liscombe, Dorset (according to 1861 Census) but I have not found her baptism. She and her husband had eleven children between 1845 and 1865 all of whom were baptised at Melcombe Regis. John CALL was an Omnibus Driver and Livery Stable Master and his name appears in Trade Directories for Weymouth between 1848 & 1875. During the latter period he was also the Licensee of the Victoria Inn, Wyke Regis (later the Ferry Boat Inn) opposite Portland, but the family then emigrated to USA with all the children except one. I have not found much about them in America though I have had correspondence with descendants of one of John CALL's brothers.

I realise the name GODDARD is fairly common but I wonder if by chance you have any more information as to Jane GODDARD's forebears. Liscombe is a very small and somewhat remote hamlet, and the Chapel there has been desecrated. I have not found any record of Liscombe in the 1841 census and although I think it may have been linked with Milton Abbas my efforts to trace Jane's baptism have been unsuccessful. It seems probable that Jane's mother was the Mary or May Goddard who was a visitor with the CALL's at the Victoria Inn, Wyke Regis. Dorset on the 1861 Census and aged 56 (b at Morlerton Dorset - ?Moreton)

Except for the fact that Jane (nee GODDARD) emigrated to USA, I do not suppose the above information is of much interest to you, but I hope you will not mind my writing in response to your invitation. My sister and I started researching our ancestors a few years ago as a new hobby on retirement and it has given us a good deal of interest.

Thank you for your letter.

I regret that no one is researching the Goddards of Dorset and we have very little material on them and the information you have sent will be kept in our records in case someone writes to us in the future with a similar family tree, when we will get in touch with you. I can also offer to put a note of your enquiry in our next available Newsletter - perhaps the July/August one- to see if anyone else can help.

I have had a look at the 1881 census of Dorset, but cannot find Mary or May Goddard, who would have been 76 by then. I cannot see any other Goddard listed who says that they were born in Moreton. However, if you would like to borrow the list to examine it for yourself you are welcome. Please send a large 25p stamped envelope.

I would have suggested that you contact the American Goddard Association about Jane, but of course she would have been a Call by the time she emigrated.

Dear Mrs Bahring,

Thank you for your letter. I enclose a leaflet about the Goddard Association of Europe.

I am afraid that our records of London Gooddards are very few for the 1900s. There are so many of them that no one has been brave enough to record them.

We can add a little to the information you already have:

Elizabeth Goddard married George Day at St Luke, Old Charlton, Kent on 30th August 1819.

This is from an entry in the I.G.I. I have tried to look up Old Charlton in the gazetteers which we have here, and also a history of Kent, but cannot find it. Either it is a very small place, or it has been absorbed into a big town. Only someone with a local knowledge of Kent could tell you. The marriage was before the national registration of births, marriages and deaths, but after the law in 1812 which required more details to be put in the marriage register of the church where the ceremony took place. You should be able to find out more from the entry by writing to Kent Record Office.

We have a member of our association who specialises in the west country - which covers Devon, Dorset and Somerset - and I will pass on your letter to him to see if he can help.
