1 Robertus DE VILAPARI SANCTO LEODEGARIO

Birth: 1010, St Leger en Yvelines-Rambouillet France
Death: 1087

Founder of the English branch of the family. Probably related to the Vicomte de Chartres. Fought at the Battle of Hastings, owned land in Avranches. He was already a land owner in Sussex before the norman conquest and is also thought to be of the family of Robert Count of Eu. Thought to be with the Clare family, descended from Robert 1st Duke of Normandy. With William the Conqueror at seige of Exeter 1068. Brompton Regis Lord of St Leger en Yvesline/StLeger des Aubees.

Lord of Socknesh or Sworkerness a manor situated in the extreme north of the parish of Brithling, Sussex, close to Battle Abbey about 32 km from the sea. A manor still exists, rebuilt in the Elizabethan era on the site of the original house. During the 12th century it was an important centre for the manufacture of armour and contained many forges. Could this be source of the "Frette" in the St Leger Coat of Arms? It was an important source of income, other lands near Rye and Winchelsea.
