I have at last remembered to get some pictures copied for you - all from Dr C.E.A. Goddard's photographic records. One of the great features of his albums is that every photograph is meticulously labelled. In chronological order you have the Wendley family altogether (top picture); CEG in his first car (top picture) outside their house; a war photograph taken on 11 July 1915 of 2VQ (Victor) as a midshipman, 2HQ (Hester) as 2nd Lieut. in the Norfolk Regiment, & father CEG as Major in the RAMC (you before Hester was killed on the Somme - so he does, of course, not appear in the final family group). Family group taken in the Wendley garden on 13 August 1932: the husbands are standing behind their wives - Victor Mildred, Si (Dorset) & Hester, CEG & ELG, Cyril & Enid, Tom & Beryl - but the children are not entirely: the first two are Joy & Michael Dorset, the Victor & Mildred's three David Jane & John (our late committee member) & Tom's two (Cyril & Enid had no children) Peter & Adrienne (the former, one of our patrons, has been dead, alas). 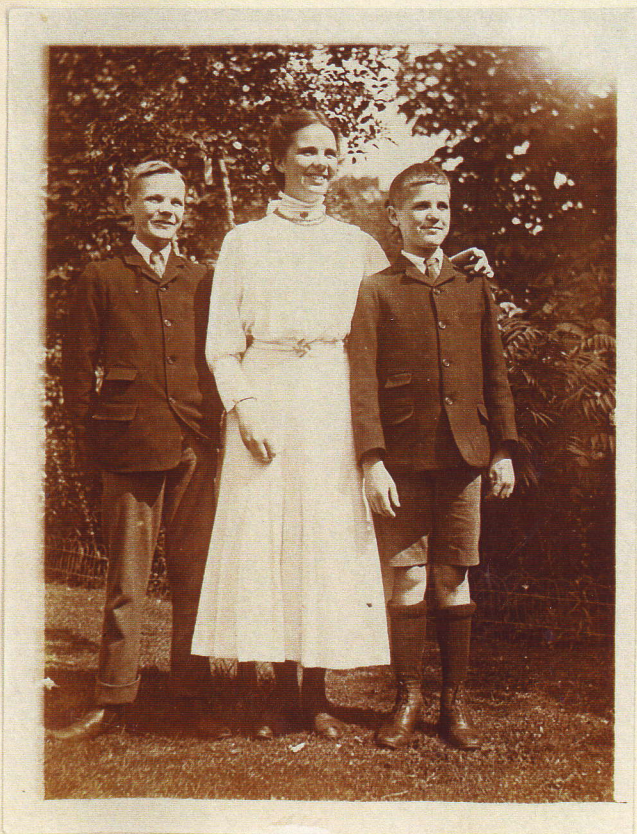
