

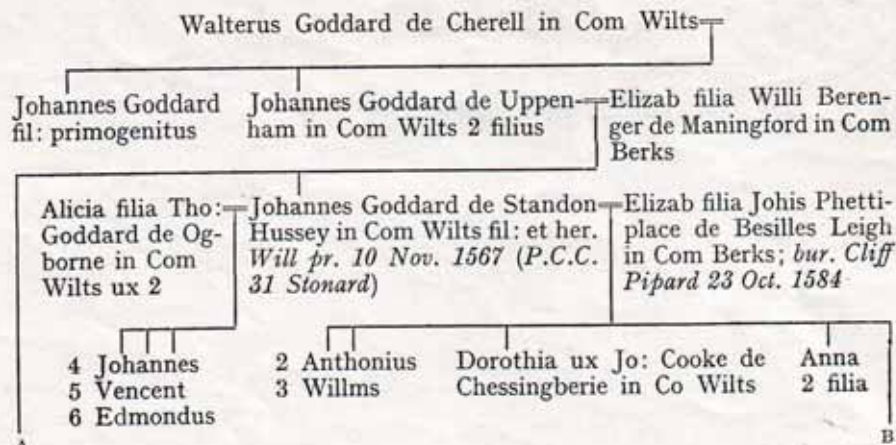

Arms:—Quarterly: 1 & 4, Gules, a chevron vair between three crescents argent; 2 & 3, Azure, a fess fusilly between three falcons' heads erased or GODDARD.²

Crest:—A buck's head coupéd affronté gules, attired or, charged on the neck with a mullet for a difference.

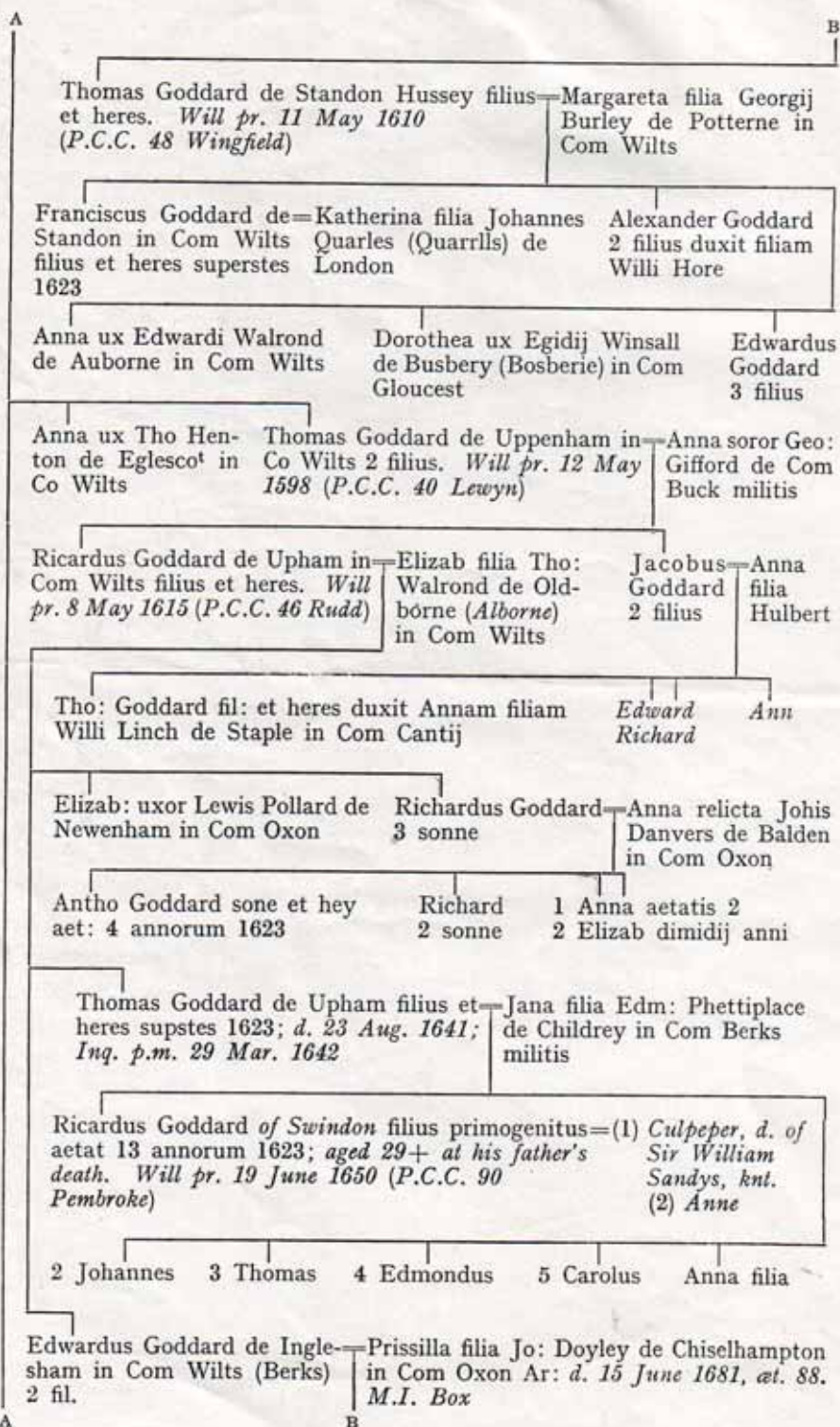

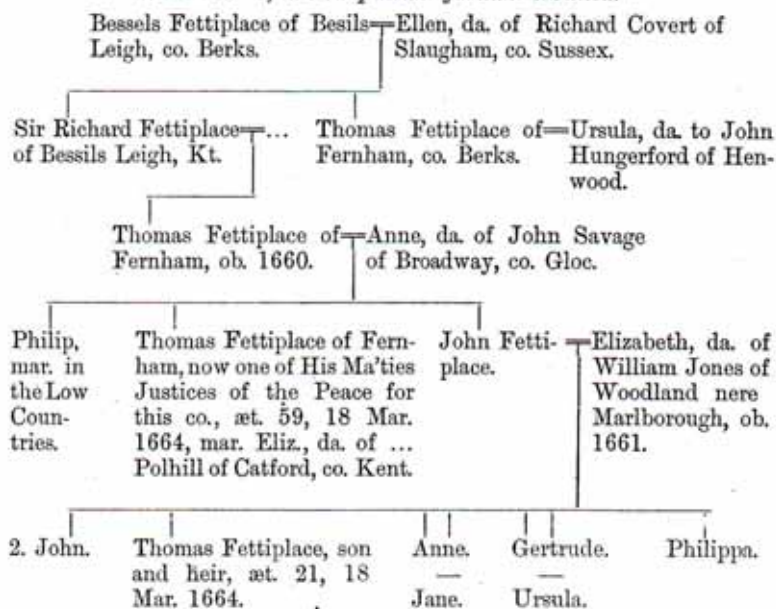

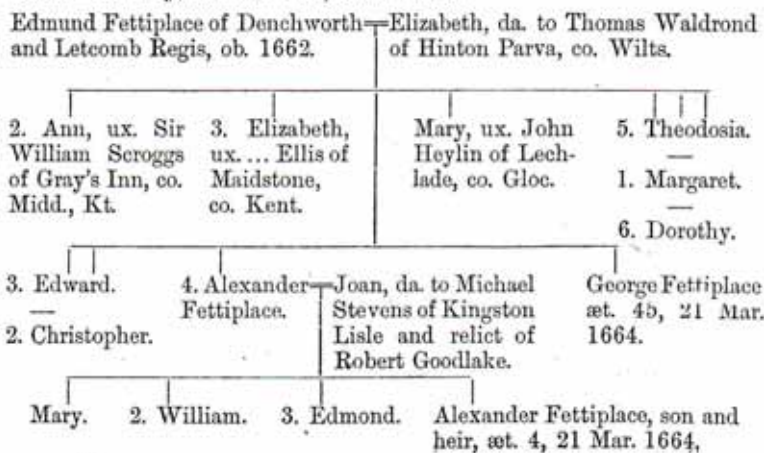

CREST.—*A dragon's head Vert, eared Gules*.

John thirde Sonne. and Myles fourthe Sonne. Suzan married to *Henry* Clyfforde of . . . in the Countie of Wiltes Esquire. Bridgett married to John Hungerforde of Downe Amney in Com' Wiltes Esquire Elizabeth married to John Goddarde of Stondon Hussey in the Countie of Wiltes Esquire.

Edmonde fetep lace of Shifforde in the Countie of Barke Esquire, Sonne and heire to John married Margaret thirde daughter to John Lorde Mordaunte of Turvey in the Countie of Bedd. and by her hathe yssue. John fetep lace his eldist sonne. Edmond second Sonne. George thirde Sonne. William fourthe Sonne. and Thomas fetep lace fift Son Elizabeth married to John Hufeforde of Dicleston in the Countie of Glouc Esquire and hath yssue John. and Abraham Margaret. Marye and Jane. Anne married to Andrew Kettlebye. of Syddington Langley in the Countie of Glouc. Esquire. Jane married to Anthonye Wyndsore of Estmayne in Com' South Esquire, and hathe yssue. Edmonde Wyndsore. And. Dorothey married to Henrye Cassye of Whitfild in the Countie of Glouc. Esquire and hathe yssue Thomas. Gyles, Margaret, and Jane. 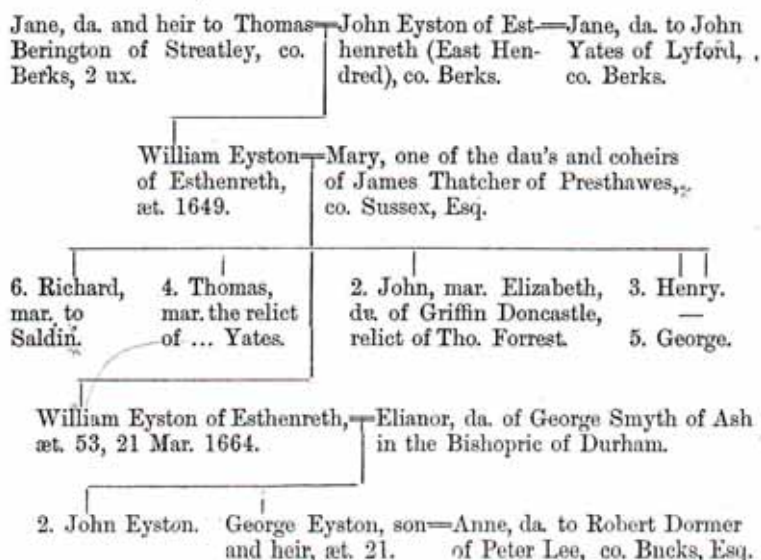

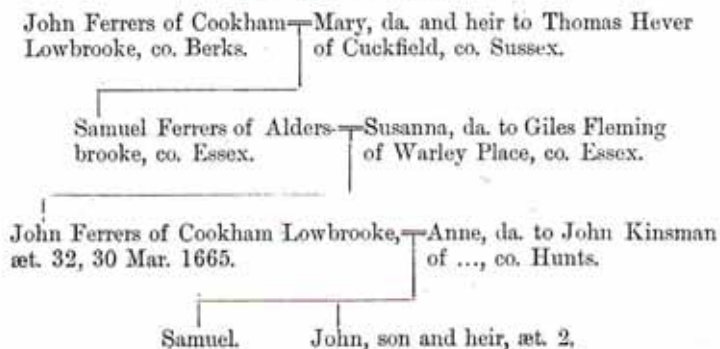

ARMS.—Quarterly of 6. 1, *Sable, three lions rampant Or.* 2, *Gules, a cross moline Argent, on a chief of the last three grasshoppers Vert* (Thatcher). 3, *Sable, three greyhounds courant in pale Argent* (Berington). 4, *Argent, a chevron Gules between three choughs Sable beaked and legged Or.* 5, *Gules, three arches Argent.* 6, *Ermine, a lion rampant ducally crowned.*



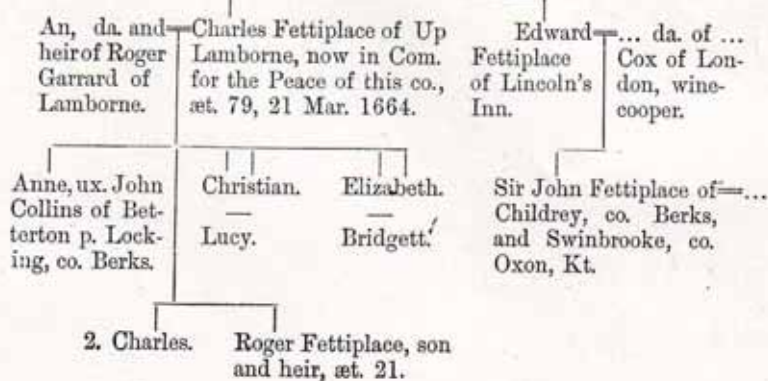
FERRERS of Cookham.
