I enclose a leaflet about the association and a sample copy of our Newsletter, for which the editor is always in need of articles by members. I am taking it for granted that you will join as membership records are in abeyance at the moment as the Secretary and the Membership Secretary are on holiday in America, and the December Newsletter came out today.


I enclose a copy of notes I made of Collingbourne Kingston records several years ago. Nowadays one is only allowed to look at microfiche records of the parish registers. Unfortunately Wiltshire was one of the first counties to put their records on fiche, when the art was very much in the learning stage. I find the fiche very difficult to read - especially as they have been in constant use for over ten years.

You will see that your John (who married Jane) was the brother of Douglas's ancestor, Henry, and both sons of David and Mary. David was born in 1797, the youngest son and ninth child of Stephen Goddard and Jane Wilkins of Easton Royal. I have a very large tree for Stephen and Jane as we have members from all over England, and some in Canada, who are descended from them.

Digest and check these facts and get back to me for further information.

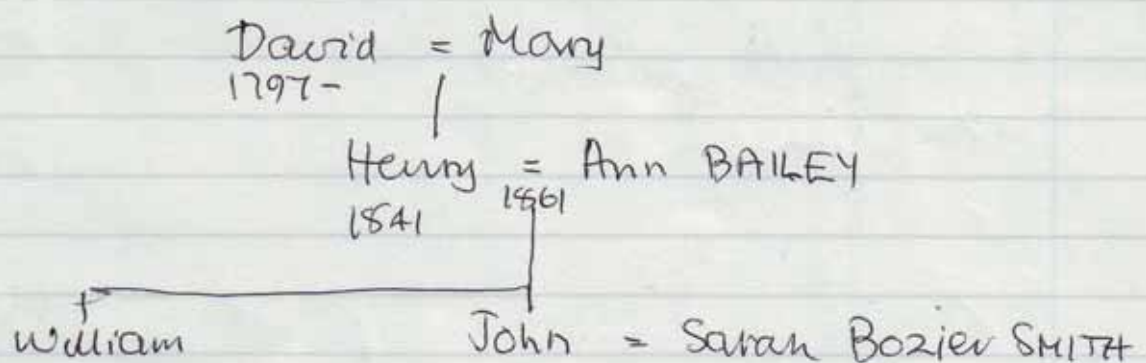
