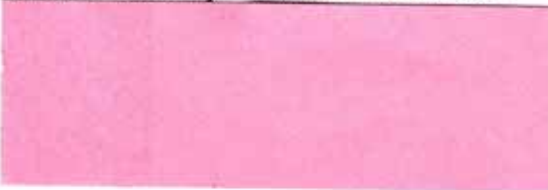

Many thanks for your letter & the enclosures re James Goddard.
I am afraid I have already found the James Goddard in Bunwell myself & have visited the church there. The church warden & I searched through the baptisms, marriages & burials but could not find James.
I thought the same as you did that I had found the right James as everything tied up. I made notes of everything that I found. However my husband is still of the opinion that they came from Wiltshire. I have James Parfitt Goddard's death & marriage certificates but have been unable to find his birth. I have searched on 1837 online.com from 1866-1875 but feel I am up against a brick wall as there are so many James Goddard's. I have also searched the 1861 Census for his father but there are so many James Goddards & last week I turned up a Joseph Goddard on the census who had 2 nephews named James staying with him at that time!!
I have also found a James P. Goddard on the 1881 census (widower) age 41 born Donhead St. Mary Wiltshire who had a son Allan P. Goddard & so wonder if he had a son James P. Goddard who was not at home at the time of the census?
I have spent hours trawling the internet & census & propose to visit Wiltshire register office next spring, I also believe there is a Goddard Library in the Museum at Devizes?
Its all very confusing & I hope that I have not bored you with my details as I am sure I do all my friends!!!!

Dear Jim,

I am sorry, I seem to have misled you and myself: I appear to have only the note that James Goddard was mentioned in the will of Robert Bugden of Donhead dated 22 May 1717, taken from the Wiltshire Strays Index. Wiltshire Record Office should be able to sell you a photocopy (though they might grumble a bit at not having the name of the ecclesiastical court which dealt with the will).

*Other people researching the Donhead Goddards are
Bernard Gillespie, 12 Rudland Road, Barnehurst, Kent DA7 6DD - descended from David bap 1811 at Donhead St Mary (last hear from 1990)
Norman Couchman, The Granary, Popes Hill, Kingsclere, Berks RG15 8SJ -descended from James bap 1796. (Last contact 1994)*

I also have details of the Goddards at Donhead St Mary in the 1841, 1851 and 1861 census if you do not already have them. I did not make them myself and cannot vouch for their accuracy, but the person making them is an ex-policeman so they are probably OK. Let me know. And of course I can tell you who was in the village in 1881 from that census.
