Here is Jennifer Walker's summary of a deed in Wiltshire Record Office;

Reference number 628/36/2

Year 1767 Lease of land from Hon. Henry Arundel of Wardour

Former deed of 1753 says land was let on 99 year lease or three lives to John Goddard of Donhead St Mary, butcher - Robert Moore of Shaston, Dorset - and Christopher Bunter. Christopher Bunter is now dead and John Goddard is surrendering his lease and starting a new one. A cottage and two pastures of 3 acres each priced at £17 each are involved. The former tenant was James Goddard.

In addition is another copyhold cottage with fish pond - the former tenants were John Bailey and then his daughter Mary Bailey - this is now to go to John Goddard.

The three lives [presumably in a new agreement] are to be John Goddard - Robert Moore of Shaston, Dorset - John, son of John Goddard, aged 16 years.

Year 1768: John Goddard starts a new mortgage of £100 from Stephen Foot, surgeon, and also has another mortgage at £88.8 0d

Year 1781: Robert Moore is now dead. £100 is still owing on mortgage. Property is now sold to Stephen Foot, surgeon.

Witnesses: John Roberts, clerk to Mr South and James son of Isaac Goddard.

I have the following bits of information which I do not think I have passed to you - mainly because I did not know that you were researching the Donheads.

Settlement certificates:

Edward Goddard and wife Ann; children Mary and Thomas aged 4; Jane aged 2.

In 1753 they were living in Donhead St Mary when their place of settlement was Motcombe, Dorset. Reference number 1753 5 15 1733SC

In 1804 Samuel Goddard of Donhead St Mary was in Wiltshire County Gaol. He was tried at the Quarter Sessions reference number 1804 1 9

Jennifer Walker spends one day a week in Wiltshire Record Office during the winter months digging out any reference to Goddards; in the spring and summer she runs a nursery garden. We are very fortunate to have her. If you want to know any further details about the first deed perhaps you would like to ask the Record Office whether it is possible to provide you with a

photocopy of the entire thing. They might say no, because it is too big, but Wiltshire are usually very reasonable and will help if they can.

Shaston is Shaftesbury, in case you did not know.

do own and acknowledge Edward Goddard and Ann his wife with
their daughter Mary aged abt seven years and Thomas their son
aged abt four years and Jane abt two years to be Inhabitants
legally settled in our said Parish of Motcombe and we do hereby
promise for our selves and Successors to Receive them into our
said Parish of Motcombe whenever they shall become Chargeable
to your said Parish of Dunhead Saint Mary. In Witness whereof
we the said Churchwardens and Overseers of the poor of the said
Parish of Motcombe have hereunto respectively set our hands
and Seals the fifteenth day of May in the year of our Lord 1753

Deed 628/36/2: Goddards of Donhead St Mary:

Year 1767: Lease from Hon. Henry Arundel of Wardour.

Former deed of 1753 was let ~~in~~ on 99 year lease or 3 lives to John Goddard of Donhead St Mary, butcher, - Robert Moore of Shaston, Dorset. - & Christopher Bunter.

Christopher Bunter is now dead, & John Goddard is surrendering his lease & starting a new one. A cottage & 2 pastures of 3 acres each at £17. Former tenant was James Goddard.

Plus another copyhold cottage with fish pond - former tenants were John Bailey then his daughter Mary Bailey - now to go to John Goddard.

3 lives are John Goddard - Robert Moore of Shaston, Dorset - John son of John Goddard, age 16 years.

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Year 1781: Robert Moore is now dead. £100 is still owing on mortgage. Property is now sold to Stephen Foot, surgeon.

Witnesses: John Roberts, clerk to Mr South & James son of Isaac Goddard.

Deed 628/36/2:

Set of 3 deeds starting from 1733.

That in 1694 James Goddard of Donhead St Mary took up a lease from Lord Arundell of a cottage & 2 pieces of land, each of 3 acres, in Donhead St Mary. His wife Lucy Goddard was 2nd life & his son James Goddard was 3rd life.

Witnesses: Henry Lacy & Mathew Haylock.

That in 1733 this lease now goes to James Goddard (junior ?) with George & James Bunter (sons of Christopher Bunter) as 2nd & 3rd lives.

Then in 1753 Christopher Bunter, tailor, is deceased. His 2 sons are not mentioned. But Robert Moore of Shaston, Innholder, pays £17 to be put on this lease.

In lease dated 1767 John Bailey has been leaseholder, but now his daughter Mary Bailey is 1st life. And John son of John Goddard appears to be 2nd life of Donhead St Mary. Rent is 13/4d per year.

Year 1768 John Goddard is borrowing £200 from Stephen Foot of Donhead St Mary, surgeon, at 4% interest.

Witnesses: Charles Butler & John Scott in 1767.
