*Thank you for your letter of enquiry. You only have to ask for information. We have a filing cabinet and some boxes all full of Goddard material.*

*A summary of the lease is as follows:*

Reference number in Wiltshire Record Office 628/36/2

Year 1767 Lease of land from Hon. Henry Arundel of Wardour

Former deed of 1753 says land was let on 99 year lease or three lives to John Goddard of Donhead St Mary, butcher- Robert Moore of Shaston, Dorset- and Christopher Bunter. Christopher Bunter has since died and John Goddard is surrendering his lease and starting a new one. A cottage and two pastures of 3 acres each priced at £17 each are involved. The former tenant was James Goddard.

In addition is another copyhold cottage with fish pond - the former tenants were John Bailey and then his daughter Mary Bailey - this is now to go to John Goddard.

The three lives [presumably a new agreement] are to be John Goddard - Robert Moore of Shaston, Dorset - John, son of John Goddard, aged 16 years.

Year 1768: John Goddard starts a new mortgage of £100 from Stephen Foot, surgeon, and also has another mortgage at £88. 8.0d.

Year 1781: Robert Moore is now dead. £100 is still owing on the mortgage. Property is now sold to Stephen Foot, surgeon.

Witnesses: John Roberts, clerk to Mr South and James, son of Isaac Goddard.

*Nb. Shaston is the old name for Shaftesbury in case you did not know.*

*Have you had the following?*

Settlement certificates:

Edward Goddard and his wife Ann; children Mary, (not sure of her age) and Thomas aged 4; Jane aged 2.

In 1753 they were living in Donhead St Mary when their place of settlement was Motcombe, Dorset. Reference number at W.R.O. 1753 5 15 1733C

In 1804 Samuel Goddard of Donhead St Mary was in Gloucester Gaol. He was tried at the Quarter Sessions reference number 1804 1 9

Also, in the 1881 census the family of Fred (19), George (25), Charles (22), and William D(?) Goddard had moved from their birthplace of Donhead to Sixpenny Handley, Dorset [just over the border in fact]

and in the 1861 census the family of William Goddard (51) Boot and shoemaker of Donhead were living at 1 Wolston Cottages, Cumberland Street, Chelsea. The children were George W.(?) unmarried shopman, Harriet E.U. (9) and Isabella (6)

I think that you have already had the references in Robert Bugden's will to various Goddards, but if you have not, please ask.

Are you in touch with David Goddard, [redacted] Frey, SM5 4DW, who is also researching these Goddards?

I am looking for information on John Candy Goddard. We know he was born February 14, 1836 but do not know where. He was married July 20 1858 to Miriam Honeyfield in Gillingham, Dorset, England and they ran a store across from the St. Mary's church where they were married. In 1871 they immigrated to Iowa, USA. They had 5 living children when they came to America. I recently found a John Goddard baptised on March 25, 1836 at Holy Trinity-Wesley Methodist, Shaftesbury, Dorset, England. I am wondering if this could be the same John Goddard. I also found a George Goddard and Elizabeth Candy married February 11, 1835 at Donhead St. Marys, Wiltshire, England. Wondering if this could be John's parents. Also wondering if he had any siblings.
