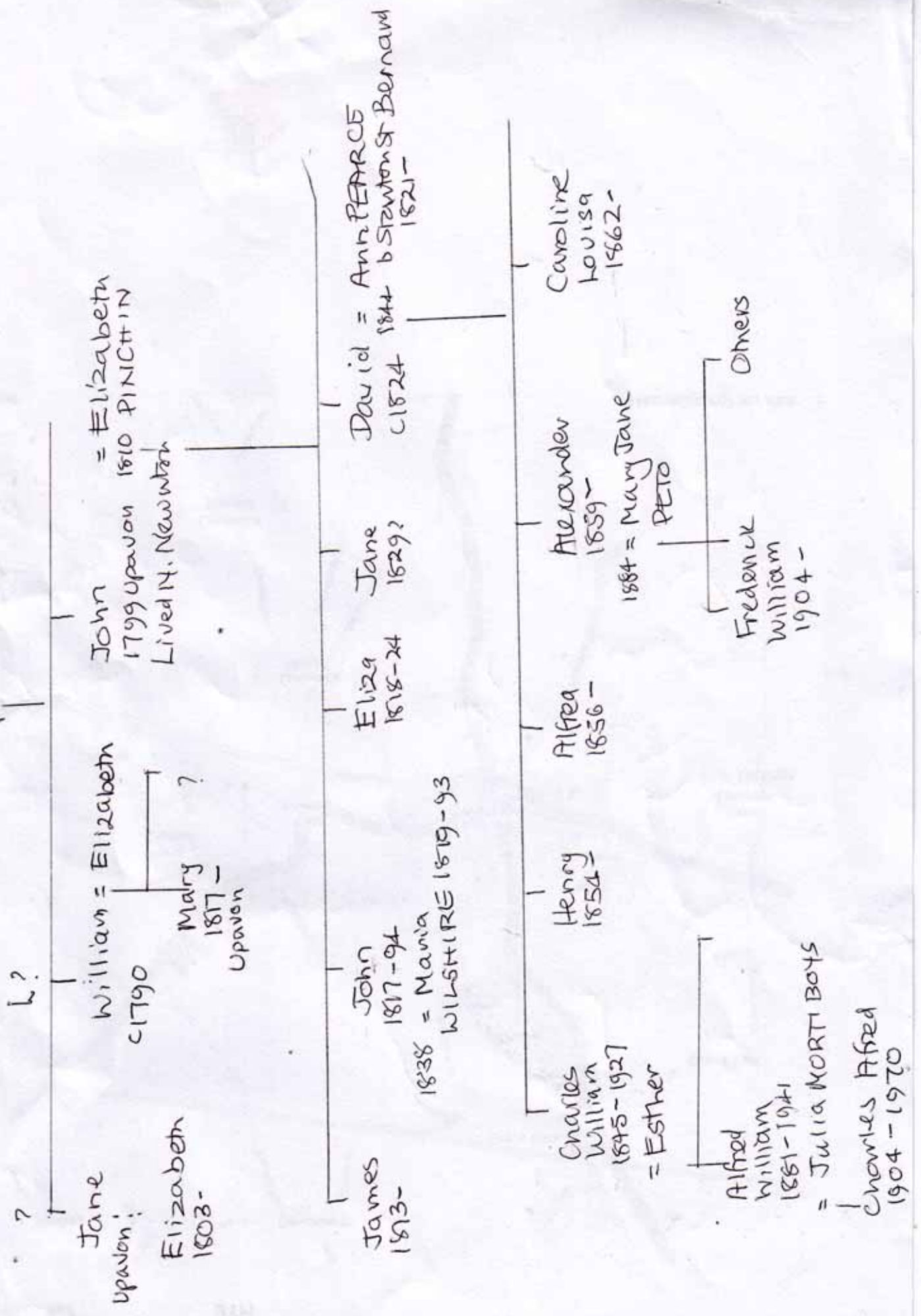

At last – at last – I have checked up on North Newton parish registers for your David Goddard marriage.

David Goddard, age 20, lab., father John Goddard, lab., married Ann Pierce, age 23, spinster, father William Pierce, 11-3-1844 By Banns.
Witnesses: William Pierce and Joseph Keepence Vicar was Francis B. Ashley.
Mark of David Goddard and Ann signed her name.

The only 4 other marriages I could find in North Newton were

John Goddard married Elizabeth Pinchin 14-11-1813

John Goddard, father John Goddard, lab., married Maria Wiltshire, father John Wiltshire, lab. 28-7-1838

Jane Goddard, father John Goddard, lab., married Henry Tilly, age 28, father John Tilly, lab. 9-3-1839

Martha Goddard, age 19, father John Godard, lab., married George Tilly, of Hilcot, of full age, no father given, 17-11-1845.

James son of John and Elizabeth Goddard bap. 18-6-1815

John son of “ “ “ bap. 6-4-1817

Eliza daughter of “ “ “ bap. 5-7-1818

Jane daughter of “ “ “ bap. 1-2-1824

Eliza Goddard, age 5 years, buried 1-2-1824

Thomas Goddard, age 9 months, of Hilcot, buried 1-4-1834

There seemed to be quite a lot of Pierce's in North Newton P.R. and I also have extracts of the following wills.

Mary and James Goddard are kin in Phillip Pearce of Durley, Burbage will proved 1803

George Goddard, son of James and Mary Goddard of Oxenwood, mentioned in Thomas Pearce of Burbage will proved 1820.

Mary Goddard, widow Barley, was married to James Goddard by the time she probated her father John Long of Durley, Burbage will proved 1802.

Has the society settled anything about research in the future yet ? have you managed to get rid of any of your paperwork yet ?
