Other branches of Goddards
living around Pewsey
Orcheston St George and St Mary

Ivor Goddard of Christchurch has traced his tree back to Joseph Goddard, who married Jane Carter in Orcheston on 25 January 1807.

They had children; Maria born 1814, Mary 1817, Joseph baptised at Orcheston St Mary 23 August 1818; and John 1820.

Joseph junior married Ann Major of nearby Elston (who, as she was born in 1832 was a lot younger than her husband) in 1848 (GRO record Amesbury 8 389). A daughter, who went by the name of Maria Goddard Major, was born to Ann early in 1848 (GRO record Amesbury 8 276).

Joseph and Ann had the following: Frank 1853; Frederick 1857; George 1860.

In the 1881 census the family are living in Ivy Cottages, Orcheston St George.

Daniel (whose surname was also spelt Matthews in other records) was a widower. He had married Maria Goddard Major in 1869 GRO record Amesbury 5a 251), but she had died in 1871 aged 23 (GRO record Amesbury 5a 129).

George married Mary Matilda Johnson at Wimborne, Dorset (GRO record Jun Q 1889 Wimborne 5a 478). Their son Charles Henry arrived a year later (GRO record Amesbury 5a 1[6 or 8]5). Followed in 1894 by Percy Edward (GRO record Sep Q 1894 Amesbury 5a 155) and Herbert George M. in 1901 (GRO record Mar Q 1901 Amesbury 5a 145).

Herbert married Hilda Mary Cox and is the father of Ivor Goddard who has given us many of these details. Charles Henry married Sarah Scott.

Joseph's brother John married Jane Heath in 1866 and in the 1881 census they are living at Orcheston St Mary. He, like Joseph, was an agricultural labourer.

*

In nearby Orcheston St George was another Goddard family. James Goddard born around 1805. He married Rhoda, surname as yet unknown, from Maddington another small village, around 1830.

They had the following children; Jane 1834; Charlotte 1837; William 1839; Elizabeth 1842; John 1844; Emma 1846; Eliza 1852.

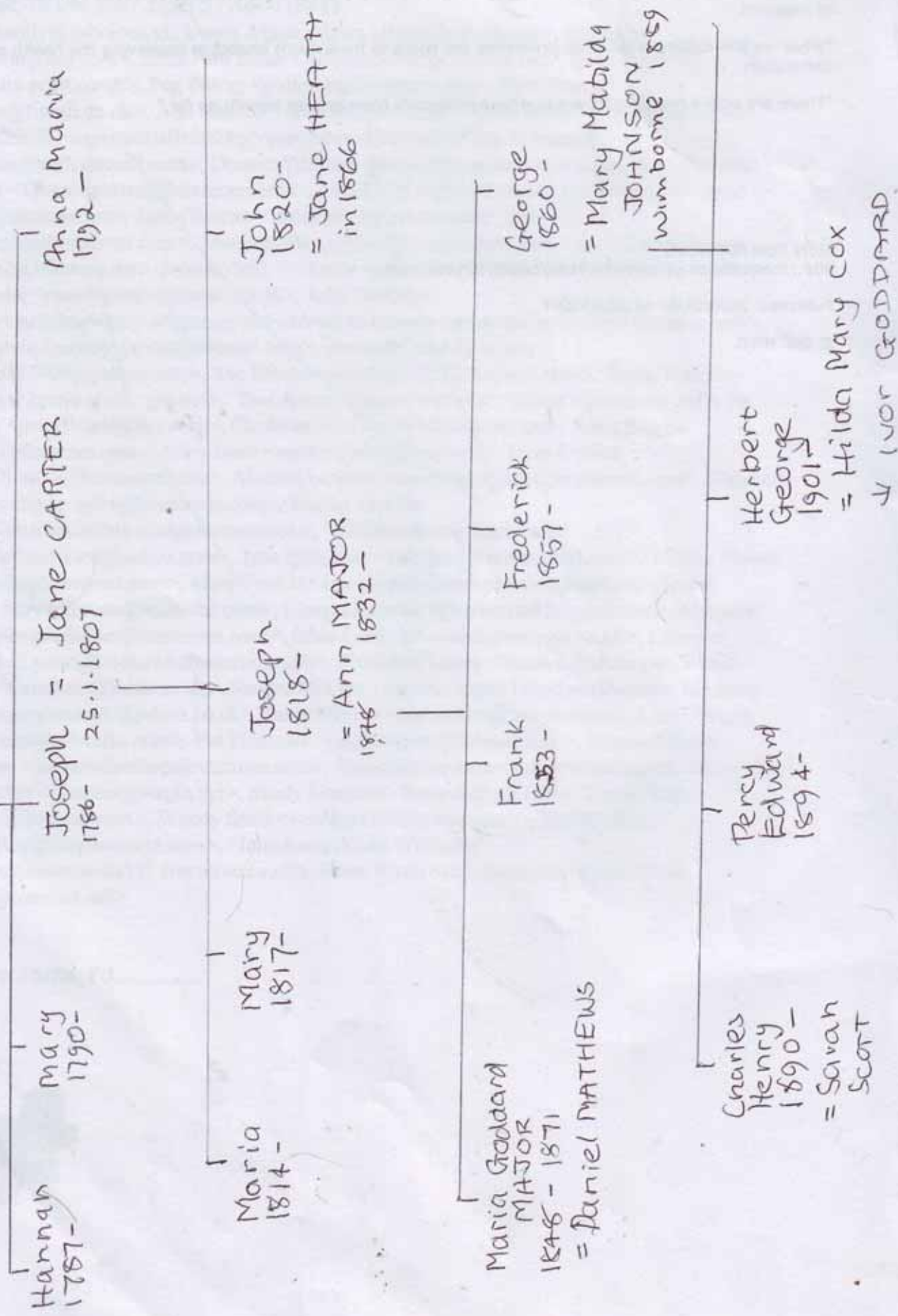
James died in 1882 (GRO record 1882 Dec Q Amesbury 5a 103) aged 76. Rhoda died in 1888 aged 79.

It may be that the William Goddard living in Orcheston St Mary, who married Jane Drewett, or Drewitt (GRO record March Q 1860 Amesbury 5a 223) is the son of James and Rhoda. He and Jane had two daughters baptised in Orcheston St Mary; Miriam in 1860 and Anne in 1868.

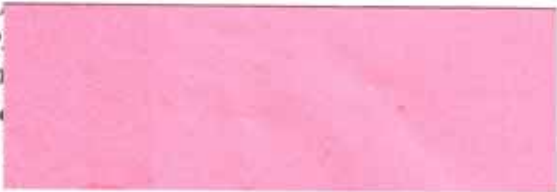

In the 1841 census Orcheston St Mary it shows:-

- Joseph (dad) 55
- Joseph (son) 20
- John (son) 20
- Maria (daugh) 25

This would make Joseph senior b.1786 +/-
Joseph senior died 1868 aged 81 (b.1787) Amesbury 5a 115.
But I cannot find the death of his wife Jane. Obviously before the 1841 census.

Do you think I am on the right track?

In the IGI records for Market Lavington it shows Joseph Goddard christened 19 March 1786 - son of Joseph and Anna Maria. They also had the following children:-

- Anna Maria b. 1792
- Hannah b. 1787
- Mary b. 1790

I was searching in the villages around Orcheston and was amazed to find in Market Lavington 42 Goddard christenings there and 12 in West Lavington. For such a small village this seemed extraordinary - in 1801 the population was only 918.

I found James and Rhodas gravestone in Orcheston St Marys churchyard. James died Dec 24 1882 aged 76; Rhoda died Oct 6 1888 aged 79.

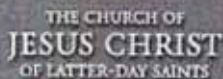

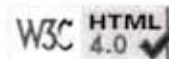
