Dear Julie,

I'm sorry for the delay in sending page 3 of my original Family Tree to you. I had written it out again for you and then realised there'd been a few alterations which needed explaining, and then Christmas letters/cards/preparations got in the way, so many apologies.

The original records, I recall, were difficult to read, hence I was able to correct my records on hearing from other people. First, Simone Lay.

a) I had previously recorded WILLIAM bp 25/12/1826 (s/o JAMES + JANE) as marrying ANN PRIDMORE but on hearing from Simone I am happy to change this to FRIBANCE.

b) Date of their marriage is 22/2/1851 not 22/7/1851 - Simone tells me they were married by 1851 census.

c) Page 2 of my original family tree. HARRIET b 13/3/1807, d/o CHARLES (bp. 29/4/1781) and ELIZABETH. I have changed HARRIET's husband to JOHN PIKE on advice from NEVILL GRIFFIN (member of Goddard Society).

d) Re FRANCES GODDARD d/o CHARLES and KIZIA (pg 4 of my original F.T. who married GEORGE KINGSTON. 1849). From 1881 census, they appear to be living at 14 Purses Sq, St George in East, London, E14, She 32, George 46 - but it says born WOOTTON BASSETT, Wilt, and there is a daughter, ELIZABETH A. KINGSTON age 14. GEORGE KINGSTON is (I am almost 100% certain) son of my Great Grandmother: JANE, nee KINGSTON, (who married WILLIAM GODDARD bp 31/3/1811 (s/o CHARLES and ELIZABETH) born to JANE KINGSTON before she married WILLIAM. (George would have been 48 years old but I've found many errors on censuses).

e) I hadn't got ELIZABETH's surname (who married CHARLES bp 20/4/1781). You give it as "FEW".

Looking at JOSEPH (b/o CHARLES and ELIZABETH)  
and JANE's children, I see I have KEW as  
the second name for ELIZABETH b1853 and  
JAMES b1855. Can you confirm this is  
definitely "FEW" sometime please, no  
rush.

I think that is all. My very best  
wishes and many thanks for doing all  
this work on the Bewsey Valley Goddards.

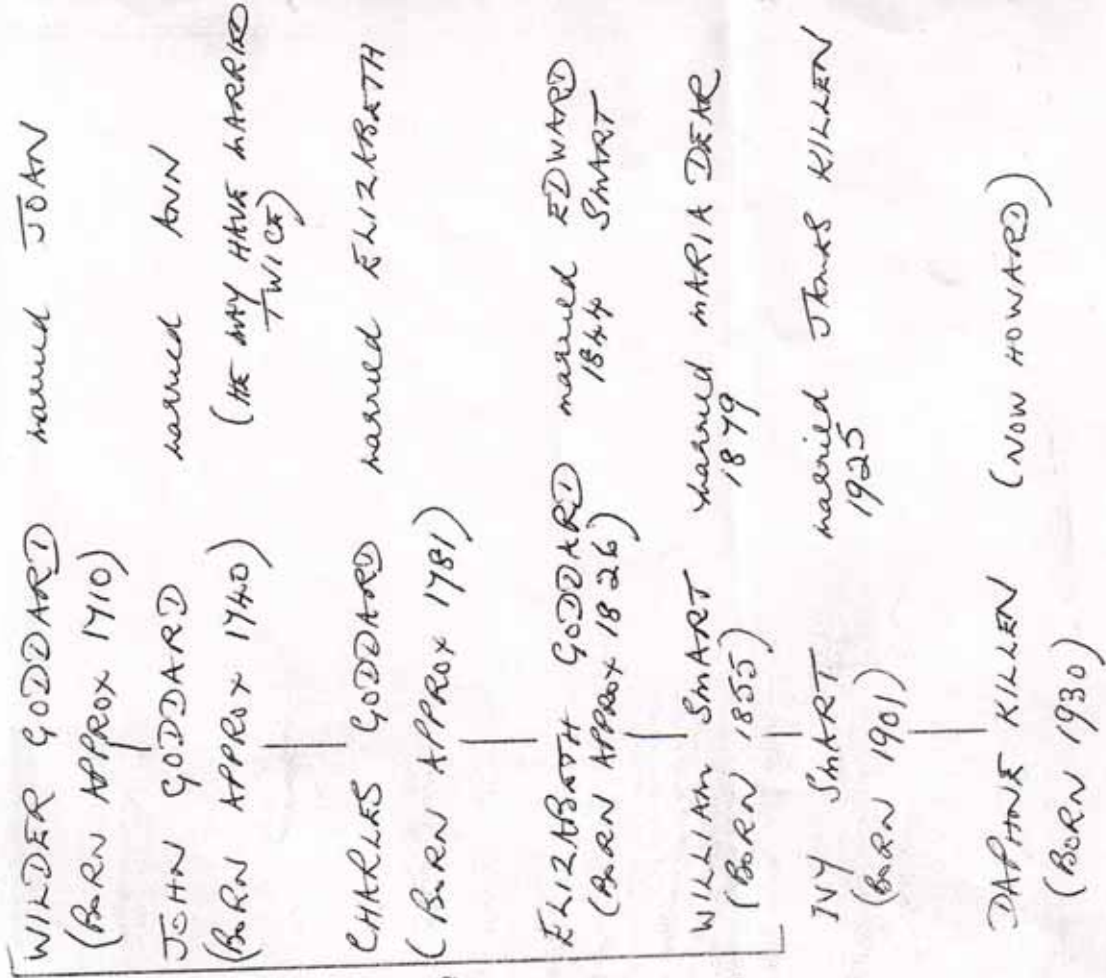

Dear Beryl,

Thank you for your detailed reply.

I think that I agree with you that there are coincidentally two John Goddards with sons named Charles who married women named Elizabeth, roughly in the same area.

Jeanne (Keith's wife who does the actual researching) found that the vicar of Hurstbourne Tarrant was also the vicar of Burbage which caused her to look further than the immediate area of north Hampshire where she was looking for Keith's ancestors. Since we have established that Wilder Goddard moved from Ogbourne St George to Wootton Rivers, a move I would have thought unlikely, I have become more open minded as to where people came from.

The vicar of Castle Eaton in Oxfordshire, a position held by the Goddards, was also vicar of East Woodhay in Hampshire, which is over a one day horse ride. Of course the hard work at both ends could, or would, be done by a curate. However, I imagine that if a young girl in either village needed a place as a live in servant, the Goddard ladies could suggest placements in both villages.

However, how did the Elizabeth who married Charles Goddard, get to Wiltshire from Bridgewater?

I will go back and look at Frank of Llanelli's tree again. Thank you for the suggested corrections. I think that many new records have become available since Frank compiled it.

Jeanne and Keith, unfortunately do not have the Book of Common Prayer with the helpful notes on the flyleaf. It belongs to a cousin who will only relinquish photocopies of the relevant pages. Jeanne feels that the original might be clearer to read in some places.

It is the time of year for literary festivals and art exhibitions, which I review for the local newspaper, so I have again been distracted from getting down to work on the Pewsey Goddards. It needs time and a clear head to gather all the threads and try to make sense of them.

The Goddard AGM is next month at Aldbourne in Wiltshire, where there were once three different families of Goddards at the same time, all in different social classes. I don't know if any of the present committee are going to resign. Peter in Toronto is being treated for cancer and Richard, the President, has just had a family bereavement. I know John and Eileen, who are Membership Secretary and Secretary were thinking of moving on to other things. We shall see.

Dear Beryl,

It is my turn to apologise for the delay in writing. Both Brian and I are finding it difficult to get into the swing again and to write up the Goddard history for the Association. Besides us finding many other things to do, we have not been spurred on by any members of the Association. I quite often wonder just why people join when they seem to have no interest in their ancestry!

The sole exceptions are you and Jeanne Goddard, the wife of Keith, who retired from work a few months ago and has thrown herself into researching Keith's forebears. Brian and Keith both supplied their DNA for analysing by Dr Denise Syndercombe Court and it has been found that they are very closely related. This is despite Keith's earliest definitely known ancestor being James Goddard born 1803 "at Tottenham House" as he always said. Brian's earliest known ancestor is James Goddard who married at Botley outside Southampton in 1808.

I have your letter of 4 January last, with its helpful corrections, and will incorporate them in the text as I compile the monograph. I have now expanded the area covered to the villages of Orcheston and Bottlesford and North Newton. However, in doing so I was reminded that I had some information on Orcheston in the files of a history of a Mormon missionary of the 1850s who hailed from the village where we used to live. He preached to the villagers of Burbage and Orcheston as part of his territory. Then I was contacted by an American, and ancestor of the companion of "my" missionary, and I was led astray as he and I supplied each other with information.

At last I have turned back to the Pewsey Goddards. As you will see from the enclosed, Jeanne has done a mass of research based on an old prayer book. In some places it differs from your findings. I would be grateful if you would look at her suggestions and see if you can either refute her findings or modify your suggestions. The crux of the matter seems to be who was John Goddard the father of Charles, who married Elizabeth Few?

I am sending Jeanne a copy of your suggestion as to John's origins.
